

In the name of God. Amen! I Amos Pollock of the County of Jones and State of North Carolina, being of sound and perfect mind and memory. Repose he took do this 10th March in the Year of our Lord 1821. make and ordain this my last Will & Testament in manner following. that is to say.

- 1st I give and bequeath to my son George Pollock. one bed and furniture. one cow. Fifty Dollars in money. my young horse. one pot. books & trunks to him his heirs & assigns for ever.
- 2nd I give and bequeath to son Thomas Pollock, one gray mare. one cow two heifers and six hogs one bed and furniture. the 2nd choice. Fifty Dollars in money. one pot. trunks to him his heirs & assigns for ever.
- 3rd I give and bequeath to my Daughter Fanny Pollock one Negro girl named Chloe. one Bed and furniture the first choice. one pot. trunks. one Tea Kettle. one Wooden Wheel. one Linen Wheel. first choice. to her and her heirs and assigns for ever.
- 4th I give and bequeath to my Son William Pollock. Six Hundred Dollars in money to him his heirs and assigns for ever.
- 5th I give and bequeath to my two Sons George & Thomas Pollock. One Hundred Dollars. Fifty Dollars each. to them their heirs and assigns for ever.
- 6th I give and bequeath to my Son McDaniel Pollock. what he owes me. and one dollar to him his heirs and assigns for ever.
- 7th I give and bequeath to my Daughters Polly McDaniel, my Son John Pollock, my Son James Pollock, my Daughter Betsey McDaniel, my Daughter Amy Mashburn, all the residue of my Estate, after paying my just debts, to be equally divided between them their heirs and assigns for ever. Lastly I nominate and appoint my worthy friend. Brother John McDaniel. Executor to this my last Will and Testament. in Witness whereof I have set my hand and Seal, the day and Year first above written.
