Kettle & three Setting Chairs & two Bed bags & all my
Bottles also one Young Cow which it is my Will and
Desire that my wife Should keep the five Children and
at her death the property to be Sole & Equally divided
among the five Children also I bear my Seven Children
that I had by my second Wife Rachle I bear one Shilly
and I bear my wife Deannah Antions & Comb soon

the day & year above written in the presence of —

you for this same do this 20 day of November in the year of
our Lord One Thousand eight hundred & seven make and ordain
this my last will & Testament in manner following (viz)

that gave it me & my Body to be interred in a decent
Christian manner at the discretion of my Executors hereunto
mentioned nothing doubting but that I shall receive the
same again through the mighty power of God and
trusting such worthy estate as hath pleased you to left
me with I give & Bequeath the same in manner follow-
ing to wit —
Item, I give & Bequeath to my daughter Sally one set
of tea cups & saucers one Small kettle half dozen Pats one
half dozen large Spoons to her & her issue forever —
Item, I give & Bequeath to my daughter Polly three
Cows & Calves one feather bed & furniture to her and
her issue forever —
Item, I give & Bequeath to my daughter Betsy one
Bull & one Cifer if they are to be joined & one large
pot & one teakettle & one sensible cook pot to her
& her issue forever —
Item, I give & Bequeath to my daughter Rachle one
Hog & Cifer with Calf one large chair & one low chair and
one piping pan to her & her issue forever —
Item, I give & Bequeath to Sarah Taylor one large
pot to her & her issue forever —
Item, I will that all the residue of my property that
is not already mentioned & particular divided by Sole &
all my just debts paid & the residue of the money to
be equally divided amongst my children —
Lastly I nominate & appoint my friend Edmund
Nalek Executor to this my last Will & Testament
reworking all former Wills by me made & Confirming
this —
