Belongs to said Mills to him and and blacksmith tools and
household tools to him his heirs & Assigns for ever
I Give and bequeath to my Son George Willcox the land I bought of
Simmons Harrison two hundred and eighty Acres More or less
to him his heirs and Assigns for ever. I Give and bequeath
to my Daughter Nancy Wood I give the I bought of Hugh Boock
and Joseph Montague Three hundred Acres more or less long on
Chalks Swamp to her her heirs and Assigns for ever
I Give and bequeath to my Son Antwine one horse to him his heirs and
Assigns for ever the same Brought to said Mack of the wife

I John Harrison of Jones County and State of North Carolina Being weak in body but of sound mind and memory Plead be good Do make and Ordain this my Last Will and Testament in manner and Form as follows that is to say, I give to my Son Levy Harrison to him his heirs & assigns forever the plantation and land where Jesse Alphin lived on my land lying on antwines branch Beginning at my Corner tree on antwines branch near Mc. Daniels fence running with my line to Parsonses Corners then down the same branch to the Beginning Containing fifty Acres be the same more or less it is my will and desire that the rest of my lands and all my Property shall be kept to gather in a Maintenance for my wife and small Children and for a home for the Older Children if they Cause to make it here home Except they Marry if my wife be cause to marry or any of my Sons or daughters they must provide a home for them selves they can have this for a home no longer it is my will and desire that all my Just debts shall be Paid and my children to be brought in a Christian like Manner it is my will and desire that my lands that is not given away and all the rest of my Property shall be Sold at publick Vendue when my Son Amos arrives to the age of Twenty one years old and the money to be equally Divided between my wife and all of my children Except my Son Levy he has Received his Dower there by Constitution and we appoint my wife Elizabeth Harrison Co. of this my last will and Testament Making void all others will by me made This 30th day of March 1822
