forever. Item I give unto my daughter Susanna Noone one feather bed and
furniture to her her heirs and assigns forever. Item I give and bequeath unto my
two sons Amos Noone and Peter Noone all my lands and to be equally divided
between them at my wifes death or when they arrive to the age of twenty one
years and to be divided from the time out to the back line —
Item my will and desire is that all the residue of my Estate be sold
by my Executor hereafter named and after paying all my last debts. the
balance to be equally divided between my two daughters Nancy Noone and
Patsie Noone to them their heirs and assigns forever. Item I leave my
Executors to lot of to my wife her years provision. I nominate constitute and
appoint my friend Daniel Noone and James Huggins Esq. Executors to this my
last will and testament the day and year above written. signed sealed and
