I Daniel Mallard of the County of Jones and State of North Carolina being aged about Eighty eight years - do make my last Will & Testament, and by this act do revoke all former Wills, declaring this to be my last Will, bearing date the 13th of December 1819. - First, I give & bequeath my body to the dust from whence it came, and my Soul to God who are the giver of all good, with the sure & certain hope that at the last day I may be raised like unto his Holy body by the merit of his atoning blood as to my worldly affairs - First, I give to my grand daughter Polly Harrison one feather bed, with what Cattle I have formerly gifted to her before, to her her heirs and assigns for ever -

I give & bequeath unto my daughter Hesiak Mallard all my Stake of Lands not formally given away, about two hundred acres, my Stock of all descriptions, Horses, Cattle, Hogs, Sheep, and all my plantation tools & household furniture of every description whatsoever. - And in Consideration of my leaving my daughter Hesiak in the former gift in which measurably consist the greater part of my Estate, my Will are, and desire is, and I enjoin it upon her, to take Care of and administer to her mother, my widow, who are too old to take Care of herself -

And if the said Hesiak Mallard for herself or by her representatives should not administer to or take good Care of my aged wife or widow, in that case I will and decree, that the property put to that purpose shall through the superintendence of the Laws of my Country be applied for her -
