I then I give and bequeath unto my Son John Quillen one Shilling Sterling and also all my estate of what ever kind shall remain after the death of my wife

Eleanor to him and his heirs forever.

Lastly I recommend and appoint my trusty friend Matthew Womack and my loving Son John Quillen Executors of this my last will and Testament to perform the same according to the true intent and meaning of the same and I do hereby revoke and disannul all other former wills in witness hereof I the said Daniel Quillen have hereunto set my hand and seal this fifth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty four
