James County and State of North Carolina being sick and weak
in body though of sound mind and memory do make and
Ordain this my last will and Testament in manner and form
following -

I. David and Desire that ^{my} Executors see and dispose of two por-
tions of my Land I hold over Mann river as also my Turpen
line and all my Crops not hereafter bequeathed also one yoke
of Oxen and an Old Mare &c. sold in Order to enable him to
pay my just debts & funeral expenses as also one Silver
Watch for the same purpose.

Item I give and bequeath unto my wife beloved Wife Lottice
three negroes named Peter, Abigail and Jude but not the
increase of them I should there be any as also one horse nam-
ed Jack eight Cows with Calves or Calfings three Sheep and
all my Crops to her her heirs and assigns forever.

Item I lend to my said wife Lottice the plantation where-
on I now live to have the same to her use & benefit until
my son Robert arrives to the age of twenty-one years or
should my said son die in minority until the expiration
of the term that he would have been of age had he lived
together with all my household goods and plantation uten-
sils and the use of one white and black horse and one Oxen
Mare one yoke of Oxen and all my Sheep and after my
said son arrives of age that my said wife have the
and benefit of the Thornesboro Quarter during her
natural life Nevertheless it is the true intent and mean-
ing of this that my said wife make good the principal
of each and every of the articles so lent at the expiration of

of the term for which they are lent -

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Sarah all
my Land lying on Muscle Shoals Swamp contained in
two patents and one equal half of Negroes not otherwise bequeathed
and a small house named Blage to her, her heirs and assigns forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my son Robert my plantation
whereon I now live also the Thornesboro Quarter and two hundred
acres of Land in the fork of Long branch also Fannings
Dictionary and Salmons Geography and one equal half of my
negroes not otherwise bequeathed to him his heirs and assigns forever.
Item I will and desire that my beloved wife have and receive
of the present Crop Forty Bundles of tanned Indian Corn all over
the place Finner place and Cotton that shall be made on my
plantation as also that she be paid and allowed by my Execu-
tors the sum of twenty five pounds specie annually out of the
profits of my Estate as an equivalent for the board of my
children -

Item I lend my said wife one negro girl named Bet to
have to her use in her own possession as like my children are
of age at which time this said Bet and the residue of my
negroes be equally divided between my two children Sarah
and Robert -

Item I will and desire that all the residue of my Estate be
sold and the money arising from the same be equally divided
between my two children Sarah & Robert and if either of my
said children should die in minority I will that her or his part of
all my estate fall to the survivor -

Lastly I do nominate and appoint my loving Brother Mar-
sam Honega sole Executor and Guardian for my children

calutely and alone to execute this my last will and Testament
ratifying and confirming this my last Will and Testament
and revoking all other wills by me made In Witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 15th April 1784.

der this my last Will and Testament and as touching that
worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me with
in this life I give Devise and dispose of the same in the
following manner to wit.

I give and bequeath unto my Son William Spock
after the decease of my beloved wife Prudence Spock one
fourth Part and Furniture also one pewter Basin one Caster

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Dish and four Plates also one Pew Staff and one Pew and Stand
and also all the whole of my personal Estate as well not named
as named excepting only the legacies hereafter particular men-
tioned to him his heirs and assigns forever.

I give and bequeath unto my Son Christian Spock one Shilling
Sterling or the value thereof in his full currency to him and his
heirs and assigns forever. I give and bequeath unto my Son
Leest Spock one Shilling Sterling or the value thereof in his
full currency to him and his heirs and assigns forever.

I give and bequeath unto my Son Phile Spock one Shilling
Sterling or the value thereof in his full currency to him and his heirs
and assigns forever.

I have unto my beloved wife Prudence Spock one fourth
Part and Furniture, and also one linen spinning wheel and
also one Loom and Cars during her natural life and I also bind
unto her my said wife all the rest of my personal estate during
her widowhood. Lastly I nominate and appoint my well beloved
wife Prudence and my friend Daniel Perry Executor wholly and
solely to execute this my last will and Testament hereby revoking
and disannulling all former wills by me heretofore made ratifying
and confirming this and no other to be my last Will and Testa-
ment.
