fer yearling apiece to them their Heirs and assigns forever and
lastly I constitute and appoint my sons William Hay, Joseph Hay,
and George Hay my whole and sole Executors to this my last Will
and Testament this day and date above written in presence of

There was the within Will duly proved in open Court by the oath of the
subscribing Witnesses and ordered to be recorded - at some time Will.
Hay qualified as Exec. thereto agreeable to Law - Ordered that Letters Testa-
mentary issue accordingly

In the name of God amen, I Edward Frank of the
County of Jones and State of North Carolina Planter being sick of body
but in perfect mind and diffisive memory calling to mind the mortality
of my body, and that it is appointed for all men once to die, do make and
declare this my last Will and Testament in manner and form as follows
I wit First and principally I recommend and bequeath my soul to the
hand of almighty God who gave it, and my body to the dust from whence
it was taken to be buried in a decent and Christian like manner at the
bottom of the hill

discretion of my surviving friends as Touching my worldly Estate with
which it has been the will of God to Endow me with in this life I Give
Demise and dispose of after my decease, as followeth Vizt

Item. my will and desire is, that all the Estate I now possess of every description
both real and personal remain in the care and possession of my Executors herein
after named until the Land I bought of James C Bryan and Edward
S. Franks be paid for and that the profits arising from my Plantations,
and labour of my negroes be applied to making that payment back
so much as will be necessary for the support of the family and schooling
my young Children, Also the profits arising from my stock and debts due
me after paying my funeral Expence and other necessary and just demand
after the before mentioned debt be fully paid or satisfied, to said James C
Bryan and Edward S. Franks

Item. I lend to my beloved wife Elizabeth Franck Five negroes namely,
Will, Jo, Lucy Fan and Amy, and their increase during her natural life

Item. I also lend to my beloved wife the use of my land and Plantation
whereon I now live containing by estimation Three Hundred Acres
and all the appurtenances therunto belonging during her natural life
likewise I lend to my beloved wife apx^s Eight Cows and Calves, Ten Sows
and Pigs, Eight head of Sheep with the increase thereof in consideration
of raising and Educating my young Children.

Item. I give and bequeath to my beloved Wife Elizabeth Franck all my
Household and Kitchen Furniture and Plantation Tools.

Item. I have Given to my daughter Eleanor Jiles dec^d on her life time of my
estate the full of her Legacy.

Item. I give and bequeath to my son Elijah Frank the land and Plantation
whereon John Franck formerly lived which I bought of James C Bryan &
Edward S. Frank containing by estimation Two Hundred and Sixty
seven acres also one half the Land I bought of Job Leary Tract containing
by estimation Two Hundred acres to him his Heirs and assigns forever,
also One negro Man named squire, One Horse called Fox, Three Cows &
Calves and the Hogs I bought of Thomas Battle.

Item. I give and bequeath unto my daughter Zilpha Frank
Two Negroes namely George and Melaly she and her increase, also
Two Cows and Calves to she her Heirs and assigns forever.

Item. I give and bequeath to my son John Martin Frank One Negro
boy called Joe, Three Cows & Calves, & Three Sons and Pigs when he
arrives at the age of Twenty One Years.

Item. I also give and bequeath to my son John M. Frank the Land and
Plantations wherein I now live after the death of his Mother and I give
and bequeath to him one half of the Two Hundred Acre tract of Land
I bought of Job Leary to him his heirs & assigns forever.

Item. I give and bequeath to my daughter Barbary Frank Two Negro
boys Hardy and Isaac and Two slaves ~~slaves~~ to her her heirs and assigns
for ever.


Item. I give and bequeath to my Grandson Edward Stankey Frank Jiles,
one Horse Bridle and Saddle with twenty five Dollars when he arrives at
the age of Twenty One Years.

Item. I lend to my Wife Three Horses, called Pachet, Match & Pink
during her natural Life.

Item. My will and desire is, that the Five Negroes and the other personal
Estate lent to my wife for life, also all parts of my Estate not otherwise dis-
posed of by this my last Will and Testament be equally divided among
all my children that are now living Namely Polly Battle Elijah Frank,
Hannah Brock Zilpha Frank, John M. Frank & Barbary Frank to them
their Heirs and assigns for ever.

Lastly I constitute and appoint my Wife Elizabeth
Frank Executrix and my son Elijah Frank Executor of this my last
Will and Testament In witness whereof I have unto set my hand and
affix my seal the ninth day of August in the year of our Lord One Thousand
Eight Hundred and Thirteen

Further my will and desire is, That of my son John Martin Franks should die before he arrives to the age of Twenty one years, that the rest of my Children that are now living shall heir his legacy, to be Equally divided among them, and also if either of my daughters should die before they arrive to the age of Twenty one years or marry that the rest of my Children that survives shall heir all their or her Legacy, to be Equally divided among them, This I make while in perfect mind and disposing memory to constitute part of this my last will and Testament, In Testimony whereof I hereunto set my hand and affix my seal the 10th day of September
