Item I also will that the remaining part of my property, whatever, be equally divided
among my aforesaid beloved sons, to wit, Lot, Levi, Cha, & Aaron & I do constitute
and appoint my aforesaid beloved sons, to wit, Lot, Levi, & Cha Executors to this my
last Will and Testaments revoking all other my former Will or Wills by me before
made I do ratify and confirm this to be my last Will and Testaments in
Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 1st day of
September 1817.

and ordain this my last will as my present feelings induces me to think I cant
live many days -

First I give to my beloved wife Elley Stafford all my stock of every kind also
the Plantation Tools Household and Kitchen Furniture all the above of every descrip-
tion during her natural life, also my Plantation with the same during her natural
life and at her death the Plantation with what stock and Tools &c. belonging and
remaining all to go to and be the property of my son Elisha Stafford giving my
wife free liberty to sell of the Stock and Plantation Tools what she may think proper.

Item I give and bequeath to my son James Stafford my negr fellow Charles I
purchased John Collins to him his Heirs and assigns forever.

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Item. I give and bequeath to my daughter Susan Stafford my elean
 Brey Charles I purchased of Jerry Williamson to her her heirs and assigns
 forever. I also bequeath to her the half Stock Gun to my

forever.
My two shot guns to be disposed of as follows the half Stock Gun to my
Son James and the Gun with the whole Stock which my Father gave me to go
to my Son Elisha Stafford - The money arising from any Property which
my Wife may sell as above mentioned to be to the joint use of my three
Children James Elisha and Susanna Stafford to be laid out for their
Boarding, Cloathing and Schooling at the discretion of their mother Aley
Stafford as she may think proper and if any of the money arising from
such sales as before mentioned be left at their said mothers death the
same to be equally divided among my before mentioned Three Children
This my last Will and Testament revoking all others I leave my be-
loved Wife Aley Stafford & Tucker Malden whole managers to my
Estate as Administratrix & Administrator - In Witness I do here under
