being at this time infirm & weak but of sound mind do make and
ordain this my last will and Testament first I commend my soul
to that all wise being who gave it to me and after my decease I wish
my body to be decently interred and as it regards my worldly goods
after my debts and necessary expenses have been paid I wish them
to be disposed of as follows

Item 1 I give unto my Son Benjamin Market one Note of two
hundred & twenty five Dollars three head of Horses ten head of cattle
my stock of Hogs Iron Beds and Bedsteads my house hold and kitchen
furniture

Item 2^d I give unto my Grand Daughter Mary Ann Market one
Bedstead and furniture and I make Chute to them their heirs and
assigns forever lastly I nominate my Son Benjamin Market Executor
to this my last will and Testament as given under my hand and
seal this 5th day of January A.D. 1843
