

In the name of God Amen!

I Enoch Davis of the State of North Carolina Jones County. Shewing all other made this my last Will and Testament. Item 1st I leave unto my beloved Wife the Plantation where I now live during her natural life time. Item 2. I give the said Land to my Daughter Peggy after the Death of her Mother. Item 3. I give unto my Wife C^{rs}. five Cows and calves and her Choice of Twelve head of Hogs and my flock of Sheep. Item 4 I leave my Horse and Mares to use of my Family. Item 5. I leave the residue of my Stock to be sold at a Credit of Six months and my share of the mill and the Land adjoining said Mill and Mill race to be sold at a Credit of Twelve months. Item 6. I give unto my Daughter Peggy one Hundred Dollars extra of the profits arising from the sale of said Mill Land and Stock. Item 7. I give to be equally divided among all my Children (after all my Just debts are paid) the amount of the sale of my Land mill and Stock, namely, Heturah, Francis, Peggy, Alfred, Eliza and Logan. Item 8. I give unto my Wife C^{rs}. her choice of one Feather Bed and furniture, Item 9. I give unto my Daughter Heturah one bed and furniture. Item 10. To my Daughter Francis one Bed and Furniture. Item 11. To my Daughter Peggy one Bed and furniture. Item 12. To my Daughter Eliza one Bed and furniture. Item 13. I give unto my Wife all my Plantation utensils, house hold and Kitchen Furniture that is not already disposed of. Item 14. I further wish my Executors to appropriate such a part of the respective shares of my Children as is necessary for their Education.

I hereby appoint Nathan Green and Allen Davis my Executors. In Witness whereof I hereunto set my hand and seal in presence this Twenty third of May 1821.
