

I Francis Andrews of the County of Ions and State of North Carolina being  
of sound mind and memory but considering the uncertainty of my earthly existence do make and declare  
this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say -

First - That my Executors hereinafter named shall provide for my body a decent  
burial suitable to the wishes of my relations and friends and that they pay all funeral expenses  
together with my just debts, however and to whom severally out of the monies that may first  
come into hands as a part or parcel of my Estate -

Item. I give and bequeath unto my two daughters Rachael Andrews and Catherine White One  
hundred acres of land lying in the fork of Husheshell and Gum Branches extending so far  
up said Branches as to include all the buildings where I now live, for and during both of their  
natural lives with the privilege of free wood and rail timber from any of the rest of my  
woodlands adjoining during the same period - I also give and bequeath unto my said  
daughters Rachael Andrews and Catherine White two negro boys in joint Stock by the names  
of George and Peter also one first choice Horse two Cows and Calves, One Cow and Pigs and  
provisions for one years support unto them their heirs and assigns forever -

Item. I give and bequeath unto my daughter Rachael Andrews One Bed and Furniture One  
Chest, One Trunk, One Dining Table and half dozen Sitting Chairs to her her heirs and  
assigns forever -

Item. I give and bequeath unto my daughter Susan Garrison all the residue of my lands  
including the first hundred acres named after the death of Rachael and Catherine,  
except the land I bought from John Roomegay and that I formerly gave my son Tom  
unto her her heirs and assigns forever -

Item. I give and bequeath unto my daughter Lucy Givett the sum of Two hundred  
and fifty Dollars, to her, her Heirs and assigns forever -

Item. I give and bequeath unto my daughter Sally Kerrett the sum of Five Hundred  
and Fifty Dollars to her, her Heirs and assigns forever -

Item. I give and bequeath unto my daughter Zelphia Sheller the sum of Five hundred  
and Fifty Dollars to her, her Heirs and assigns forever -

Item. I give and bequeath unto my daughter Lucy Debrule the sum of Five Hundred  
and Fifty Dollars to her, her Heirs and assigns forever -

Item. My will is that all of the residue of my Estate of every description should be  
equally divided between all of my children -

And lastly I hereby constitute and appoint my son in law Daniel Garrison  
and my friend Nathan Foscue Executors to this my last Will and Testament -

I Jonas Jones of the County of Jones and State of North Carolina, do make and  
publish my last Will and Testament as follows, viz:  
First I direct that my body may be decently buried, and that my funeral may be conducted  
by my Executors herein after named, in a manner corresponding to my Estate and situation in  
life, And as to such worldly estate as I have placed Almighty God to intrust me with, I do  
make of the same as follows: First I direct that all my debt and funeral expenses be  
paid as soon after my decease as possible out of the first monies that shall come into the  
hands of my Executors, as a part of my Estate.

Item 2d. I bind unto my second wife Eliza Frances Jones my Fountain Williams Plantation  
my negro Girl Dilsey, my negro man Tom, and his wife Lucy and their youngest chil-  
dren which Dilsey has now bring during her natural life; and I give and bequeath to her  
the said Eliza Jones as her absolute property One thousand Dollars in Cash, to be paid  
to her by my Executors, out of the first monies which shall come into their hands from any  
portion of my Estate; also two head of horses her choice; three Cows and Calves; four Ewes and  
lambs; four Sons and Daughters, Bedsteads, and furniture, half dozen Chairs, and One  
Bureau, also every Article of property which her father has hitherto given her or may here-  
after give her, And I do further direct my Executors to lay off and allot to my said wife  
Eliza Jones out of my Estate a comfortable support for herself and family for the  
space of one year.

3d: I give and devise my Fountain Williams plantation with all the improvements  
and appurtenances therunto belonging to my daughter Francis Ann Jones and  
her heirs forever, subject to the life estate of her mother Eliza Francis Jones therein  
except. I give and devise to my son Amos Jones and his heirs forever all the  
lands embraced in what is called and known as my "Home Plantation" also so much  
of the Hoville Tract as lies on the West side of Riddle Snake Branch, together with all the im-  
provements and appurtenances to said lands belonging.

4th: I give and devise to my daughter Susan Jane Jones my Coop Roads Plantation
