 County in North Carolina being of sound mind and memory do
 make and ordain this my last will and Testament in the
 following manner First I commend my soul unto God
 who gave it and desire when I die to be buried in a Christian
 like manner at the discretion of my Executors and as to
 the worldly estate with which it hath pleased God to bless me
 I dispose of the same in the following manner.

I give to my loving wife Sarah Sible two feather beds and
 furniture six Cows & Calves six young Steers and six hogs &
 pigs to her her heirs and assigns forever and I lend my
 wife Sarah Sible all my household furniture and the
 use of the lower part of my dwelling plantation from
 the middle of the new house down the branch and
 also the use of my negroes George, Sam, and Rich and
 two horses called Rock and Salisbury for and during her
 widowhood and no longer in full of her dower in all my
 Lands and in full of her share of my Estate but in
 case my said wife Sarah Sible shall in any manner
 or oppose or endeavor to hinder or obstruct the execution
 of this Will accordingly to the true intent and meaning
 thereof or shall claim any right of dower in any of the
 Lands here by or professed of other than as expressly given
 by this will then and in that case I hereby revoke and
 annul all the assents herein made to her the afore
 said Sarah Sible and do give her the P. Sarah the sum
 of twenty shillings currency of this State in full for her
 share of personal Estate and in this last mentioned case
 the negroes George, Sam, and Rich with the household

goods Cattle hogs and hives are to go to my natural son
 John Sible formerly called John Gilliard whose name was
 altered from John Gilliard to John Sible by an Act of Assem-
 bly passed at Newbern in November one thousand seven hun-
 -dred and twenty seven to him his heirs and assigns forever
 I give my nephew William Sible the sum of thirty pounds
 currency in full of his part of my Estate and I give my
 nephew John Sible one negro man called Loman in full
 for his part of my estate I give devise and bequeath to my
 aforesaid natural son John Sible after the death or inter-
 marriage of my said wife Sarah Sible which ever may first
 happen all and singular the Lands Negroes and household
 furniture which by this will is lent to my said wife Sar-
 ah Sible during her widowhood to him the said John
 Sible his heirs and assigns forever I also give and devise
 with my aforesaid natural son John Sible all & singular
 the rest and residue of my estate both real and personal
 of what kind or denomination soever to him his heirs and
 assigns forever reserving & appointing my respected
 friend Richard Caldwell with my aforesaid natural son
 John Sible and James Coor Executor of this my last will and
 Testament to perform the same according to the true intent
 and meaning thereof hereby revoking & disannulling all
 former wills by me made and it is my desire that in case
 I should survive my aforesaid natural son John Sible that
 all and every part of my estate given to him by this will
 shall be equally divided by an order of Court amongst the
 Children of the said John Sible for their heirs heirs
 and assigns forever In Witness whereof I have hereunto
