

In the name of God Amen
 I Henry Rhodes of the County of Jones and State of North Carolina being of
 sound & perfect mind & memory do this the 27th day of July A.D. 1849 make and publish
 this my last Will and Testament in manner following that is to say.

First. I leave unto my beloved wife Wilpha all my land lands lying on the South
 side of the publick Road leading from Fayetteville to New Bern, with the except
 ion of the small lots on the Wilmington road near the Onslow line, with the
 privilege of clearing a piece on the South side of Little Cappo Creek that is
 under fence & of clearing the lands within the ditches, cut by Jonas B. Jones for me
 with the privilege of getting fire wood, rail timber and other necessary timber
 for keeping the buildings & plantations in order the same of the whole of my lands
 to have and to hold during her natural life.

Second. I give to my wife all my Household and Kitchen furniture, family wagon
 & harness, Hogsheads and barrels necessary for salting her years provisions, one Spade
 one Shovel & Mancare fork all her choice, four ploughs three set of gear four
 weeding hoes, three grub hoes, three axes, one cart body and pair of wheels & gear
 all her choice, one Saw, one drawing knife two chisels one Hatchet one Hammer
 and four Augers her choice, Salt trays all the Bas, Dairy & furniture Garden ball
 the poultry, Two Mules Dick and Cricket, or her choice of two Mules or Horses,
 six Cows & Calves, fifteen head of Sheep, six Pigs and Pigs all her choice.
 And a plentiful support of every thing that is necessary for herself and family
 and Stock, of all kinds for twelve months.

Third. I give to my beloved wife one Negro girl named Elvrey to her & her heirs forever.
 Please to her & others during her natural life time, namely Lott, Daniels, Alfred,
 Mehaley, Matilda & Hilly my wish is for my wife to keep the younger children of
 Mehaley and the children of Matilda until they are large enough to live out or
 take away from their mothers. Also I desire my wife to be furnished out
 of my Estate money necessary to have the Barn & Smoke house repaired a sum
 not exceeding Fifty Dollars.

Fourth. I have heretofore given to my daughter Mary E Hatch lands that I value at two thousand
 dollars & other property to the amount of one hundred & twenty dollars and one note of hands
 on Richard Hatch of five hundred dollars. And have also given to my son Henry E.
 Lands that I value at Twenty eight hundred and twelve dollars and other property
 to the amount of Two hundred & Ninety five dollars. I have heretofore given to my
 son John one Bay Horse named Green one saddle & Bridle all worth Seventy Dollars.

Fifth. My will and desire is that after all my just debts are paid that my daughter

Mary O'Heatch, John M. F. Edward H., Anthony E. Bryan J. and Hannah R. shall all be made equal to the amount I have hitherto given my son Henry E. And after that the balance of my property to be equally divided among the whole of my children.

Sixth. I wish my Executors to keep my Hogs and Cattle until they take the run of the fields & potato patch, or until the Hogs are fat.

Last. I hereby make and ordain my son Henry E Rhodes & my son in law Richard J. Heatch Executors of this my last Will and Testament. In witness whereof I the said Henry Rhodes have to this Will and Testament set my hand & seal the day & year above written.
