son Samuel Macky one Bed and furniture also
two Cows & calves one small Iron pot one hand mill
I give unto my Granddaughter Margery
I give one shuter Yearling - I give unto my Wife
one bundle of flay of harnesses with
all my other household furniture hogs and other
~~Articles~~ not named only so much as will satisfy
my last Will. Item I appoint my Beloved
Wife I seal Macky & William Musick Senr
Executors of this my last will & Testament and
