of Calves two Pairs of pants, one Dow of Eight pigs, one
Sugar Box & Small Trunk, four Chairs, two Bowls, one
Copper pot, one Maple dining table, to her, her heirs
and assigns forever - Item I give of Bequest to my
Son James Busick one negro Woman named Ann
(Slave) Except the first living Child she shall have
after the Decease of which said Child I give unto
my grand son Thomas Busick to be delivered to him by

Cows & Calves two pairs of Lambs, one Pewter Dish

Pigs, one Iron pot one Coffe mill, one Large stone
pot, one Pine Table to him & his heirs of assigns, forever
Item I give of Bequest to my Grandson Stanton
Moore (son of my son James) one Negro Boy Name
(Slave) to him his heirs of assigns, forever -

Item I give of Bequest to my Grandson Thomas Busick
one Horse Bridle of Saddle, one Bed Bedstead
of Furniture, one Cow of Calf of twenty pounds in Money
to be Raised by my Executor out of the Remainder of
my Estate not herein before Given or Bequeathed. -
of the residue of said Remainder (after the Twenty
pounds is paid to my Grandson Thomas) to be Equally
divided. Amongst all my Children & their children
