 he arrives of full age to be Executors of this my last will &
 Testament assuring that they will be me decently buried
 and put this will into execution and I do hereby make
 and announce all former wills by me heretofore made

The sum and sum of my estate I leave for the payment of my just debts & if the same shall not be sufficient my will is that my Mother & Sister bear equal parts in paying remaining in consideration of the legacies left them and the surplus if any I give to my Sister Nancy. Truly I do appoint my Son & Mother Constance Reynolds Executors of this my last will and Testament hereby revoking and annulling all former wills by me made declaring this and that alone to be my last will & Testament in writing when I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this seventh day of February Anno Dom 1785. —
