In the name of God Amen I James Watson of Swain County & State of North Carolina being weak in body but of sound mind and memory calling to mind the mortality of man do make and ordain this my last will & Testament in manner following that is first of all I recommend my soul into the hands of God that gave it and my body to be buried in a decent manner at the discretion of my Executors hereunto named And as for my worldly goods when worth of both I leave to God to bless me with I give and dispose of as follows
 First I give and bequeath unto my son James Watson all my Land above mentioned three Negroes Call'd Robinson Tom & Martin three head of horses and all the Cattle in his marks and the key that is now call'd his one bed & furniture and the household furniture that is now in his hands all what is now in his possession to him his heirs and assigns forever I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife one negro woman call'd Hannah six cows & calves eight ewes & lambs and as many hogs as I have Call'd both two mares Call'd Peggy & Abigail and all my plantation tools to her her heirs & assigns forever Further I lend to my beloved wife Sarah Watson my house & other building with the part of the plantation which is my apple orchard peach orchard and along the avonnie to the road or from the bottom just above the apple orchard and along the avonnie to the road with scrubland of fire wood & timber for plantation use to her during her natural life I give one negro woman Call'd Sarah and all my household furniture The my beloved wife giving my four youngest children one bed furniture at their coming of age I give and bequeath to my Daughter Sarah Watson one Negro Woman Call'd Violet one horse call'd Nimrod four Cows & Calves four ewes & lambs to her her heirs & assigns forever I give to my son Ematt Watson one horse call'd Hickory and my silver shoe box and key & assign forever I give to my son John Watson twenty Dollars to him his heirs & assigns forever Further my will & desire is that all my beloved wife decase all my Land (except that part which I have given) to be equally divided between my three youngest sons Ematt John & James and as for the best of my Negroes my will is that they be equally divided between my three sons Ematt John & James and my Daughter Sarah at my Daughter's coming of age a marriage between her and her increase to be equally divided between the four as three sons and my daughter when they have their decase Further my will is that my Executors hereunto named shall sell the upper part of my plantation and the negroes that may be for my youngest children until they come of age and as they come of age for them I have here part further I constitute and appoint my Brother James Watson my son James Watson & my Friend Joseph Sanderson Executors and my beloved wife Executrix to this my last will and Testament and my beloved wife Executrix to this my last will and Testament to be read all other and former Wills by me made at any time and declare this to be my last will and Testament in writing which I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 20th day of February 1798
