I give my son in Law John Sananor the note that
against him I have the Corn and meat on the planta-
tion to ^{my} Wife for ^{the} use of the family I give each of ^{my}
Children the Cattle in his or her respective Marks -
I do Nominate & appoint my once beloved Wife Emma
Edward Whitley & John Sananor Executors of this
my last Will & Testament revoking all former Wills
By me made in Witness whereof the said John
Granade hath hereunto set his hand & seal this
21st January 1791.

James Watson one Tract of Land lying on Hunt branch
ing down by his acres which he hath already sold also one
Negro fellow called Lark with the rest of the articles he
hath in his possession to him his heirs & assigns forever -
I give & Bequeath to my son Moses Watson one
piece of parcel of Land containing one hundred

ten Acres more or Less which he hath already sold
also one Negro fellow called Tom which he hath
sold with the rest I have him now in his possession
to him & his heirs forever. I give & Bequeath to
my son Jeremiah Watson two Negroes Toney and
Calup leaving at his Pleasure part or with Calup
& Toney is divided with the rest of the Articles I have
him now in his possession to him his heirs & assigns
forever. I give & Bequeath to my son in Law David
Williamson one Negro Wench called Peg with her
Increase which P. girl he received at his Marriage
with my Daughter Anna Williamson a Week which
I have given him a Deed of Gift for her & her
Increase now in his possession with the other Articles
I have him at his Marriage to him his heirs and
Assigns forever. I give & Bequeath to my son in
Law Egedon Pitts one Negro wench called Rose to
him his heirs & Assigns forever. I give & Bequeath
to my granddaughter Fenne Grant one Negro girl
Daughter of the aforesaid Rose named Alice to
her & her heirs & Assigns forever. I give & Bequeath
to my grandson Stephen Grant one Negro Boy called
Lester son of the aforesaid Rose to him his heirs and
Assigns forever. I give & Bequeath to my son in Law
Francis Munday one Negro Wench called Hannah
with her two children Nancy & Sam now in his
possession to him his heirs & assigns forever. I give and
Bequeath to my granddaughter Prudence Simmons
one Negro Boy named by name to her her heirs &
assigns forever. I give & Bequeath to my Granddaughter

Sarah Simmons one Negro Boy named Luke son of the late
named Hannah to her her heirs & assigns forever. I give &
Bequeath to my son in Law Richard Smith one
Negro Boy called Tom which a discharge of all
debts due me also fifty Pounds currency to be paid
out of my Estate at the Direction of my Executors
to him his heirs & assigns forever. I give & Bequeath to
my son in Law Bazel Grant one Negro girl named
Killet with her Increase & one Bed with the rest of the
Articles he received at his Marriage with my Daughter
Pety to him his heirs & assigns forever. I give &
Bequeath to my son Nichodemus Watson my Dwelling
Plantation with the Lands thereunto Belonging that
I have a right to also one Negro Man called Jacob one
Negro Boy called Samuel one Negro Boy called Paul
also one Negro wench called Alice also three Head
of Horses & four Steers & Robin also all my Planta-
tion Tools of Every Kind also two Beds of Furniture
I give I give and Bequeath to my Daughter Mary
Watson one Negro wench called Abedance also
one feather Bed of Furniture to her & her heirs
forever. . . . with one small ^{new} bell also
one Acre of Land due me from Jeremiah Watson
to the amount of Twenty Pounds currency to her her
heirs & Assigns forever. Further my Will & Bequeath
is the Remainder of ^{my} Estate of Every Kind which is
not already given, that it be Equally divided
Between my two children Nichodemus & Mary
Watson when my son Nichodemus arrives at the age of
Twenty one years of Age my Daughter Rhoda

that the Division should be at the Marriage and
further my will is that if Either of ^{my} ~~the~~ ^{my} Children
Should die Before they marry the Surviving Part

here and published this my last will & Testament
in manner & form following, First I lend to my Loving
Wife Ann the use of my Plantation to her & her heirs
and all my Land on the west side of Tuckahoe join-
ing Thar to enclosing all my Land that I bought of
Jacob Schuster enclosing my wife Ann Jones widowhood
and in case my wife should ~~many~~ many it is my will
in that the said Land & Contain should be divided
my son Allen comes of age I also lend to my Loving
Wife Ann two Horses such as she will choose, ^{said} and four
Cows and ~~to~~ calves and to three two year old others an
thirty two, two year old hogs and thirty hogs more
old & all my Crop of Corn and fodder & as much of
my Macks as I shall be judged to be a sufficient
for the use of my family till a another Crop come
to hand I also lend to my Loving Wife Ann two
other Beds & Furniture and all my Kitchin
Furniture and one Cloth Loom and all my Cooper
ware and all my Plow one Cart and all my Guns
and plantation tools and one Grindstone and all the
Lovers house furniture and all my stone & earthen
ware and all my powder and all my spinning wheels and
chest and one small place hutch and one pair of
Stillins and two shot Guns one pair of silver dregs and
Lovers enclosing my wife Ann Jones widowhood I also lend to
my wife Ann for four years enclosing her widowhood
