I John Andrews Senr of the County of Jones and State of North Carolina Knowing the uncertainty of life and mindful of the obligation upon every man to leave his affairs in order do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form as follows viz

Imprimis It is my wishes that all my Just debts be paid I leave all my Estate to my Wife Sarah Andrews during her natural life at her death I leave to my daughter Elizabeth Harrison all the Land that was wiled to me by the death of my Father I also leave to my daughter Elizabeth Harrison during her natural life the Land I bot of my Brother Peter Andrews during her natural life at the death of my daughter Elizabeth Harrison I gave all the Land that I have leave to my daughter Elizabeth Harrison to my Grand Son James L. Harrison I give to my Son Peter Andrews and John Andrews all my River Land that I Bot of my Son Adam Anders at the death of my Wife Sarah Anders I leave my Son Peter Anders and John Anders my Executors at my death in witness whereunto set my hand and seal in Presence of September 21st 1840
