Plead me god to make and Ordaine this my Last Will and Testament in manner
and form as follows that is to say I give to my son Levy Harrison to him
his heirs & assigns forever the plantation and land where Juse Alphir lived
on my land lying on antunes branch Beginning at my corner tree on
antunes branch near Mc Daniels fine Runing with my line to Parsons
Branch then down the said branch to the Beginning containing fifty
Acres be the same more or less it is my will and desire that the rest of
my lands and all my Property shall be kept together for a Maintenance for
my wife and small children and for a home for the older children if they
Cause to make it here home each of them Marry if my wife be cause to
marry or any of my sons or daughters they must provide a home for
them also they can have this for a home no longer it is my will and desire
that all my just debts shall be paid and my children to be brought
in a Christian like Manner it is my will and desire that my lands that
is not given away and all the rest of my Property shall be sold at publick
Vander when my son Amos arrives to the age of Twenty one years old and
the money to be equally divided between my wife and all of my children except my
son Levy he has received his Dower Where by constituted and appointed
my wife Elizabeth Garrison Executrix of this my last will and Testament
Making void all others will by me made the 30th day of March
