In the name of God Rmn. I John Polee of the  
State of North Carolina, and County of Jony, being well stricken in years, though in  
perfect health, and in sound mind and memory, knowing it is appointed for all men  
once to die, do therefore make and ordain this my last will and Testament, this 8<sup>th</sup> day of  
August in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight Hundred and Twenty three. I recommend  
my soul to Almighty God that first gave it, my Body to the Earth, to be buried in a decent and  
christian like manner at the discretion of my Executors here after to be named. And concerning what  
worldly estate as it has been pleased God to bless me with in this life, which I am now possessed with  
I leave and dispose of the same in manner and form following. (To Wit)

Item 1<sup>st</sup> I give to my son John Polee, five dollars, to him, his Heirs and Assigns forever.

Item 2<sup>d</sup> I give to my son Nathan Polee five dollars, to him, his Heirs and Assigns forever.

Item 3<sup>r</sup> I give to the Heirs of my Son William Polee five dollars, to them, their Heirs and Assigns forever.

Item 4<sup>t</sup> I give to my Grand son Frederick, five dollars, to him, his Heirs and Assigns forever.

Item 5<sup>th</sup> I give to my Grand son Samuel Cox, five dollars, to him, his Heirs and Assigns forever. —

Item 6<sup>th</sup> I give to my Grand Daughter Catharine Bryan, five dollars, to her, her Heirs and Assigns forever.

Item 7<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath to my Daughter Polly Polee, four negroes, named, Daniel, Lang, Westcott  
and Rachel, One Bedstead, Bed and furniture, and one Chest, to her, her Heirs and Assigns forever.

Item 8<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath to my Daughter Huldy Sutton, four negroes named, Venus, Jordan  
Shelly & Emory, One Bedstead, Bed and furniture and one Chest, to her, her Heirs and Assigns forever.

Item 9<sup>th</sup> I give and bequeath to my Daughter Harriet Polee, four negroes named, Shil. Benah,  
Deliah, and Abigail, and one Bedstead Bed and furniture, and one Chest, to her  
her Heirs and Assigns forever.
