County of Jones being weak in Body but in sound-
Mind and Memory knowing that it is appointed for
man to do what is proper to make and ordain his
last will and Testaments in manner and
form following vizt — & first of all I recommend
my soul unto Almighty God that gave it and
my Body I committ to the Dust from whence it
was taken in faith believing this of shall receive
it again at the resurrection of the just fashioned
like unto Christ's glorious Body no man to see
Corruption all in and thro the mediation and in-
teffusion of Jesus Christ the righteous —
and as for my worldly Goods that it hath been given
God to bless me with I give and bequeath
in manner and form following vizt —
I give and bequeath to my Son John Hooce Ninety
acres of Land lying on Jacobs prairie in Jones County
to him and his heirs forever — Item I give and bequeath
to my Neys Mann Beck to be sold and the money arising
by such sale I give and leave to be Equally divided
between my sons George and John Hooce —
Item I give to my son George one Calf but save one
Gristone and my riding Saddle —
Item I give to my son John one Whelp save one new
hounds I also give to my two Sons George and John
Hooce all my Carpenter Coopers and Shoemakers
tools to be Equally divided between them I also give
to my before mentioned sons my Stills with the tubs and
stilling utensials after the death of their affectionate
Mother — Item I give to my grandson John Hooce
the son of my son George my small shot gun —
Item I give and bequeath to my two Grandsons James
and John Hooce the sons of my son John all my Stocked
butter after the death of my wife Esther Hooce to be
Equally divided between them —

I Stearne Give and Bequeath to my beloved wife Cation
Kroone one riding horse called Jack also one young-
mare called Polly with all her further Increase
also all my Silver and Gold Coin that I have laid
up in store also all my Stock of Hogs and Sheep
hens and salt provisions to her and her heirs forever
I Stearne Give and Bequeath to my Daug. stars Buckee
and Barbry Kroone one feather bed furniture and Bed
sheet ~~the~~ a Sampot and one Linen White Cloth -
I Stearne Give to my loving wife Cation Kroone during her
natural life me & his Woman Nell and Seven Children
- and my Frankey wifly Cat Sam Caesar Venus and
little Nell also all my household Goods and furniture
feather Bed & furniture no otherwise mentioned in -
this Will also all my Kitchen furniture also utensils
of Husbandry of Every Kind also all my Crockery ware
of Every Kind also land to my said wife my store -
with the utensils thereunto Belonging during her
life and also all the Stock of Cattle -

I Stearne Give and Bequeath (at and after the Death
of my loving wife Cation) to my four Daughters name
by Ann Brown, Rachel Kroone, Lichy Brown Cation
Gilbert and Barbry Kroone the below named negro
Woman Nell and Seven Children. Frankey wifly Cat
Sam, Caesar Venus and little Nell together with all
their further Increase to be Equally Divided to and
amongst my aforesaid four Daughters but if any
of my said Daughters Should Die before their ap-
portionate Mother and leave issue lawfully begotten
then my Will is that such Issue shall have their
part that the Mother would had she been living
I also give to my aforesame four Daughters after
the death of their Mother all the household Goods -
and furniture feather Bed and furniture Kitchen -
furniture Crockery ware and utensils of Husbandry
that is left in this Will to my said wife to be byways

Livida amongst them in the same manner that the aforesaid
Woman Nell and Frankey is directed to be divided between
and their heirs forever East the River and Utensils for -

Bible I Give to my son George Kroone after the Death
of his Mother, and Lastly I do nominate and appoint

Will or Wills hereof made by me before this day
ratifying and confirming this and this only on two sheets
