


One A. and all my Crockery ware, to or Heirs forever.

10th My will further is that my Stock of Horses, Hogs, the Balance of my Stock of Cattle, Pigs, the Balance of my Tools, my Crop and Provisions, with all other of my Household and Kitchen Furniture, with every thing else of my Property of every thing and nature be sold, and all my just debts paid, and the Overplus of the money arising from said Sale, to be equally Divided between my Four Sons Benjamin, James, Daniel, and Samuel after paying, or giving over to my Three Daughters Elizabeth Peperat, Sarah Horne, and Mary Pitman, One Dollar each, I having distributed to them before

11th And Lastly, I nominate and appoint my friend Isaac Brown my sole Executor to this my last Will and Testament, Ratifying, this, this and no other Raking, all and every other former Will, by me in any wise made ~~by~~ before and fully confirming this and no other - In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this the 11th day of January 1817. ^{his}

and duly qualified as such ordered that Letters of Testamentary issue accordingly

I John McDaniel Sen^r of the County of Jones and State of North Carolina being
weak in body but of sound mind and memory doth this 19th day of April in the year
of our Lord 1817 make and ordain this my last Will and Testament
in manner and form following that is to say

I give unto my daughter Anna Clark, One step-sister named Alice
McDaniel, and to my Son-in-Law John Clark, to a sum aggregate

- 2^d Item. I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Polly M^cDaniel One negro woman named Fannah to her, her Heirs and assigns forever.
- 3^r Item I give and bequeath unto the two Children of my Daughter Peggy M^cDaniel Dec^r. Daniel and Alicey M^cDaniel one negro girl named Meriah, to them their Heirs and assigns forever.
- 4th Item I give and bequeath unto my son Silas M^cDaniel One negro man, named John One Hundred Acres of Land that I bought from Edmon Taylor also One Hundred Acres on the Pecoson called the Eusey ground also all my right and title to land warrant of Forty Acres to him his Heirs and assigns forever.
- 5th Item I give and bequeath unto my son Morris M^cDaniel One negro boy named Peter also six and a half Acres Land adjoining his own lines which is undivided to him his Heirs and assigns forever.
- 6th Item I give and bequeath unto my Son Thomas M^cDaniel one Negro boy named Dave one Feather Bed and Furniture and one Plow and Gears to him his heirs and assigns forever.
- 7th Item I give and bequeath unto my son Daniel M^cDaniel Five Hundred Dollars to be paid out of the residue of my estate to him his Heirs and assigns forever.
- 8th Item I give and bequeath unto my son Risdow M^cDaniel one Negro negro girl named Sally to him his heirs and assigns forever.
- 9th Item I give and bequeath unto my son John M^cDaniel all my right and title in all the Lands it being the residue of the old pattern out of which he now claims to him his heirs and assigns forever.
- 10th Item I give and bequeath unto all the Children of my son James M^cDaniel dec^r. Five Shillings to be divided among them all to them their Heirs and assigns forever.
- 11th Item My Will and desire is that the residue of my estate be sold by my Executors of all kinds whatsoever and the Legacy to my son Daniel M^cDaniel be first paid and the remainder after paying my just debts be equally divided between my Daughters etmy Pollye Polly M^cDaniel and the two Children of my Daughter Peggy M^cDaniel the two Children to have only their mothers part and the money coming to the two Children of Peggy M^cDaniel be put in the hands of my son Risdow M^cDaniel as his Guardian and be put to Interest to them their Heirs and assigns forever.
- 12th Item I hereby constitute and appoint my two sons Risdow M^cDaniel and Thomas M^cDaniel my Executors of this my last Will and Testament - revoking and making void all other Wills by me made signed sealed inscreas of 3

There was the last Will and Testament of John McDaniel Sr. dec'd. duly proved
in open Court by the oath of William McDaniel Esq^r at the same time the Executor
therein named duly qualified as such ordered that letters of Testamentary issue
accordingly

In the name of God amen I John Eubank of Jones County
and State of North Carolina being sick and weak in body yet thanks to
God of sound mind and memory of understanding do make and ordain this my
last Will and Testament in the following manner and form viz first it is my
Will that all my just debts be satisfied and paid. —

I will and bequeath unto my beloved son Aron Eubank my house in which I
now live & all the Land on the North side of the Branch which I bought of Isaac
Gibson to him and his heirs forever I also will and bequeath unto my said
beloved son Aron all the property I have in my possession that belonged to his
mother before I married her also one Yoke of Oxen and the Cart that I now own
also Half my Hogs, also one Feather Bed and Furniture to him and his Heirs
forever, I also will and bequeath unto my said beloved son Aron one Negro boy
named Stephen and Five Acres of Land lying between his above mentioned Land
I have willed to him & my son Lewis Land it being part of the Land which
I bought of Elijah Eubank to him and his Heirs forever.

I will and bequeath unto my beloved sons to wit Lot and Ola equally one Negro
woman named Dabillah and her increase if she should have any after the
present date. I also will and bequeath unto my beloved sons Lot and Ola one
negro boy named Ners.

I will and bequeath unto my beloved son Levi Eubank Three Hundred dollars
which I have given him for the boy Donum which I willed to him in my former
Will and then sold him.

I will and bequeath unto my said son Ola Eubank all the Land which I bought of
Isaac Gibson on the South side of the Branch with a small piece of Land in and
Joining the field which I bought of said Gibson not exceeding Ten or Twelve Acres
being part of the Land I bought of Elijah Eubank it is my Will also that my said
son Ola Eubank shall have a road along the line between my Land and Daniel
Eubank's land running through the will to my said son Ola one Hunting Gun.
