

One Sh. and all my Crockery ware, to or Heirs forever.

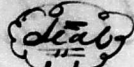
8th I give unto my Two Sons Daniel and Samuel to be used between them, my Cart and gear for the same, my Steel Trap my Razors and hone, and Curing Knife.

9th I give all my Punter to be Divided Between my Two Sons Daniel and Samuel Mashburn.

10th My will further is that my Stock of Horses, Hogs, the Balance of my Stock of Cattle, Bees, the Balance of my Tools, my Crop and Provisions, with all other of my Household and Kitchen Furniture, with every thing else of my Property of every thing and nature be sold, and all my Just debts paid, and the Overplus of the money arising from said sale, to be equally Divided between my four Sons Benjamin, James, Daniel, and Samuel after paying or giving over to my Three Daughters Elizabeth Preperat, Sarah Horner, and Mary Pitman, One Dollar Each, I having distributed to them before.

11th And Lastly, I nominate and appoint my friend Isaac Brown my sole Executor to this my last Will and Testament, Ratifying this, this and no other Revoking all and every other former Will, by me in any wise made ~~before~~ before and fully confirming this and no other. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this the 11th day of January 1817.

I John McDaniel Sen. of the County of Jones and State of North Carolina being weak in body but of sound mind and memory on this 19th day of April in the year of our Lord 1817 make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say
I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Bell, One negro girl named Cloe
I give and bequeath unto my Son James Mashburn, One negro girl named Cloe

- 2nd Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Polly McDaniel One Negro woman named Fannah to her, her Heirs and assigns forever.
- 3rd Item I give and bequeath unto the Two Children of my Daughter Peggy McDaniel Dec^d Daniel and Silcey McDaniel one Negro girl named Meriah, to them their Heirs and assigns forever.
- 4th Item I give and bequeath unto my son Silas McDaniel One Negro man named John One Hundred Acres of Land that I bought from Edmond Taylor also One Hundred Acres on the Pocason called the Eusey ground also all my right and title to said warrant of Forty Acres to him his Heirs and assigns Forever.
- 5th Item I give and bequeath unto my son Morris McDaniel One Negro boy named Peter also six and a half Acres Land adjoining his own lines which is undivided to him his Heirs and assigns forever.
- 6th Item I give and bequeath unto my Son Thomas McDaniel one Negro boy named Dave one Feather Bed and Furniture and One Plow and Hears to him his heirs and assigns forever.
- 7th Item I give and bequeath unto my son Daniel McDaniel Five Hundred Dollars to be paid out of the residue of my estate to him his Heirs and assigns forever.
- 8th Item I give and bequeath unto my son Risdon McDaniel one Negro negr girl named Sall to him his heirs and assigns forever.
- 9th Item I give and bequeath unto my son John McDaniel all my right and title in all the Lands it being the residue of the old patten out of which he now claims to him his heirs and assigns forever.
- 10th Item I give and bequeath unto all the Children of my son James McDaniel dec^d five Shillings to be divided among them all to them their Heirs and assigns forever.
- 11th Item My Will and desire is that the residue of my estate be sold by my Executors of all kinds whatsoever - and the Legacy to my son Daniel McDaniel be first paid and the residue after paying my Just debts be equally divided between my Daughters Amy Polloch Polly McDaniel and the two Children of my Daughter Peggy McDaniel the two Children to have only their mothers part and the money coming to the two Children of Peggy McDaniel be put in the hands of my son Risdon McDaniel as then Guardian and be put to Interest to them their heirs and assigns forever.
- 12th Item I hereby constitute and appoint my two sons Risdon McDaniel and Thomas McDaniel my Executors of this my last Will and Testament - revoking and making void all other Wills by me made signed sealed in presence of 3

In the name of God amen. I John Eubank of Jones County and State of North Carolina being sick and weak in body yet thanks to God of sound mind and memory & understanding do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in the following manner and form Viz First it is my Will that all my ^{and other property papers} just debts be satisfied and paid. —

Item I will and bequeath unto my beloved son Aron Eubank my house in which I now live & all the Land on the North side of the Branch which I bought of Isaac Gibson to him and his heirs forever I also will and bequeath unto my said beloved son Aron all the property I have in my possession that belonged to his mother before I married her also one Yoke of Oxen and the Cart that I now own also half my Hogs, also one Feather Bed and Furniture to him and his heirs forever, I also will and bequeath unto my said beloved son Aron one Negro boy named Stephen and Five Acres of Land lying between his above mentioned Land I have willed to him & my son Levi's Land it being part of the Land which I bought of Elijah Eubank to him and his heirs forever.

Item I will and bequeath unto my beloved sons to wit Lot and Cha equally one Negro woman named Delilah and her increase if she should have any after this present date. I also will and bequeath unto my beloved sons Lot and Cha one Negro boy named Ners.

Item I will and bequeath unto my beloved son Levi Eubank Three Hundred dollars which I have given him for the boy Donum which I willed to him in my former Will and then sold him.

Item I will and bequeath unto my said son Cha Eubank all the Land which I bought of Isaac Gibson on the South side of the Branch with a small piece of Land in and joining, the field which I bought of said Gibson not exceeding Ten or Twelve Acres being part of the Land I bought of Elijah Eubank it is my Will also that my said son Cha Eubank shall have a long the line between my Land and Daniel's Land out to the main Branch I also will to my said son Cha one Hunting Gun.
