First I give & bequeath unto my Grand son Nathan Sitvester Nutbrook Watson one Bed & Bedstead and furniture for the same and ten dollars in money.

I do also give and bequeath unto my three Grand Children the heirs of Lewis Smale one hundred & fifty dollars to be equally divided amongst them their names are as follows Lewis Smale & Mary Smale & George Smale.

I do also give and bequeath unto my Grand daughter William Nobles wife of William Nobles the sum of Ten dollars

I also give and bequeath unto my Daughter in law Mary Nutbrook the sum of Twenty dollars

I also give and bequeath unto my Grand son Benjamin Nutbrook Son of Herman Nutbrook the sum of ten dollars

I do also give and bequeath unto my Grand son Jesse Nutbrook Son of John Nutbrook the sum of ten dollars

I do also give and bequeath unto my Daughter in law Dovey Nutbrook wife of Herman Nutbrook the sum of ten dollars.

I do also give and bequeath unto my Daughter in law Feby Nutbrook the wife of John Nutbrook the sum of ten dollars

I do also give and bequeath unto my Grand Children the heirs of Abraham Smale the one dollar each their names are as follows James Smale & John Smale & Silvester Smale

I do also give and bequeath unto my Grand daughter Catharine Nutbrook the sum of one dollar.

I do also give and bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Oliver the sum of five dollars.

I do also give and bequeath unto my Grand daughter Catharine Nutbrook one Bed & Bedstead & furniture for the same.

The balance of my Property if any after my decease and my wife, do cease to be equally divided between my two Sons Herman Nutbrook and John Nutbrook whom I hereby appoint sole Executors of this my last will and Testament I Witness whereof I have signed set my name and seal the 10th day of July 1843 John Nutbrook
