 Jones County - The last will and Testament of John
 Jarman decd was duly proved in open Court by the oath
 of Christopher Bryan one of the subscribing witnesses thereto and
 ordered to be recorded at same time the Executors therein named
 qualified as such a quorum to law Order that letters of
 Testamentary issue accordingly -

In the name of good chance I John Garrison of County
 of Jones in the State of North Carolina being at this time weak
 in body but of sound mind and desiring memory and calling to mind
 the mortality of the body and knowing that it is appointed for all men
 once to die, doth make and ordain this my last Will and Testament
 in manner and form followinge To Wit, First of all I recommend
 my soul to God who gave it, and my body to be buried in
 a plain Christian like manner at the discretion of my Executors
 And as touching such worldly goods as it has pleased the almighty
 to endow me with I Will and dispose of in the following
 manner To Wit, First I bequeath unto my beloved Wife Nancy
 one half the land and plantation I now live on including the
 plantation house and all my houses (excepting such part as I have
 already conveyed by deed to my son James), to be for her
 proper use and benefit during the term of her natural
 life or Widowhood I also bequeath to my Wife (during her
 life three Negroes, one ~~man~~ a man named London one a
 Woman named Lucy and the other a girl nearly grown
 named Aris also one bed and furniture (her choice), three
 cows and calves (her choice), of my stock. One Woolen and
 one Linnen Wheel two Tables two Chairs one half my Crockery
 Ware one half my ~~furniture~~ Furniture two Hens two breeding
 hens one pullet and two oxen one Cart (her choice)

one third my stock of sheep and one third a my stock of sheep one
Church. Hills, and what ever of my other lands she may wish to
have one half my flax cotton and Wool and as much Corn
and meat as my expenses may seem sufficient for the
support of herself family and stock for one year. and three
thirds of her. I also bind my wife one more called Blage
during her life but the increase of said mare I bind
to her during only her widowhood and then to return to
my heirs as hereafter directed. Then I give to my son Benham
German Five pounds and no more having given already what
I intended for him. Then I give and bequeath to my daughter
Anne Lacey Standby One pound and no more having already
given her what I intended for her. Then I give to my
son Emanuel Thirty pounds and no more, having heretofore given
him nothing but some of what I intended for him —
Then I give to my son James Five pounds together with
what I have heretofore given him by deed of gift. Then I
give to my son John German all my lands I bought
of John Winick Red fields and Tunes Land (not
heretofore conveyed or otherwise disposed of) also my lands
on South prong and great branch. Also one negro
boy named Jim. one mare called Lightfoot One bed and
furniture two cows and calves, and the sum that I —

bought of Joseph Winick to him his heirs and assigns
 forever. Then I give and bequeath to my son Haul all the
 Lands which I bought of the exec. of Jacob Johnson
 dead, (excepting the part given to Amos Johnson, but to have possession
 of only one half until the death or marriage of my beloved
 Wife I also give unto my son Haul one negro man named Sam
 one Horse of the Value of forty pounds Cash one Yoke of Oxen
 two Cows and Calves and the remainder of my Stock of Hogs
 and Sheep one bed and furniture and my Hunting Gun
 to him his heirs and assigns forever I also on the following
 Condition give to my said son Haul, at the death of my
 Wife Three Negroes London Lucy and Arie to him and
 his heirs forever. Now I wish it distinctly understood that
 the Condition above alluded to of the gift of these three Negroes
 London Lucy and Arie. is that he my said son Haul and
 his mother together raise and support my younger Children
 free and clear of my Charge whatever untill they come of
 age or marries If they should neglect to comply with this
 Condition then the three said Negroes are to be sold for
 the expenses of raising and supporting my said younger
 Children. I also give to my son Haul the Stock ^{remaining} after the death
 of my Wife to him his heirs and assigns forever.

One third my stock of sheep and one third my stock of sheep one
Church. With, and what ever of my other goods she may wish to
have one half my flax cotton and wool and as much corn
and meat as my expenses may deem sufficient for the
support of herself family and stock for one year. and three
stocks of bees. I also lived my wife one name called Blage
during her life but the increase of said name I lived
to her during only her widowhood and then to return to
my heirs as hereafter directed. Then I give to my son Peter
German Five pounds and no more having given already what
I intended for him. Then I give and bequeath to my daugh-
ter Lucy Standish One pound and no more having already
given her what I intended for her. Then I give to my
son Emanuel Thirty pounds and no more, having heretofore given
him ~~nothing~~ that sum of what I intended for him —
Then I give to my son Amos Five pounds together with
what I have heretofore given him by deed of gift. Then I
give to my son John German all my lands I bought
of John Wink and Jethro and Joseph Saunders (not
heretofore conveyed or otherwise disposed of) also my lands
on South prong and great branch. Also one negro
boy named Jim. one name called lightfoot One bed and
furniture two cows and calves, and the barn that I —

bought of Joseph Winick to him his heirs and assigns
 forever. Then I give and bequeath to my son Haul all the
 Lands which I bought of the Court of Jacob Johnson
 dead, (excepting the part given to Amos Jannan, but to have possession
 of only one half untill the death or marriage of my beloved
 Wife I also give unto my son Haul one Negro man named Sam
 one Horse of the Value of forty pounds each one Yoke of Oxen
 two Cows and Calves and the remainder of my Stock of Hogs
 and Sheep one bed and furniture and my hunting Gun
 to him his heirs and assigns forever. I also on the following
 Condition give to my said son Haul, at the death of my
 Wife three Negroes London Lucy and Arie to him and
 his heirs forever. Now I wish it distinctly understood that
 the Condition above alluded to of the gift of these three Negroes
 London Lucy and Arie. is that he my said son Haul and
 his mother together raise and support my younger Children
 free and clear of any Charge whatever untill they come of
 age or marries. If they should neglect to comply with this
 Condition then the three said Negroes are to be sold for
 the expenses of raising and supporting my said younger
 Children. I also give to my son Haul the Stock ^{remaining} after the death
 of my Wife to him his heirs and assigns forever. —

Then I give to my daughter Betsey one Bed and furniture to
her her dress and apparel for ever. Then I give to my daughter
Rachel one Bed and Furniture Three Cows and Cattle to her
her dress and apparel for ever. Then I give two hundred to
my daughter Nancy One Bed and furniture and three Cows and Cattle
to her her dress and apparel for ever. Then I give to Haul Bag all my
lands on Jones Branch and Duckhorn Creek also the Sun Cattle his
to him his dress for ever. Then my Will is that the ~~the~~ named
Negroes So W^h James called little Jim, Hancock. Isaac ~~Stephen~~
Moses Elong. be divided by lotting equally among my
three ~~eldest~~ daughters Betsey Rachel and Nancy which
said Negroes I give to them and them her for ever.

Then my Will is further is that a negro man Samuel
Johnson and a negro woman named Rose with their
increase be sold together with such other of my stock
and household Furniture (not otherwise disposed of) which
may be most conveniently spared at the discretion of my Executors
and out of the money arising therefrom all my just debts
should be paid also all the legacies herein named and
made. The remainder together with the income of the
Negroes I lend to my wife with all the monies due me
I give to be equally divided amongst my four sons
