

In the name of God Amen. — I Joseph Brack
of Jones County and State of North Carolina being weak in body
but of sound disposing mind and memory do make and declare this to
be my last Will and Testament in manner and form following — It is
to Say — I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Mary Brack one
half of my lands and plantation whereon I now dwell (except the land
I purchased of Lewis Bryan dec'd) together with one part of my dwelling
house being that part below stairs which is the three rooms to the kitchen
— and a half the use of all my other out houses the use and labour
of six negroes namely, Peter, Bille, Sam, Tony, Hyeah, little Bille.

Old Kate half my plantation tools and my utensils therein belong-
ing, the labour and service of two horses, mares, Shays and Dill
cows, if they or either of them die the deficiency to be filled up with such
like hoes one riding chair and harness one fourth part of all my
hogs Shays and Cattle (except castrated), all my household goods and
kitchen furniture (except such things as I shall hereafter mention
for and during his natural life. My Will is further that my
wife shall have left off to her a sufficient quantity of Peas
Corn fodder peas &c. as will serve her and family one year —

Item. . . I give and bequeath to my son Martin Frank
Brack the land and plantation whereon I now dwell purcha-
sed of Nathan Bryan dec'd also two hundred acres of land
adjoining the above mentioned land, patented in my own
name (reserving to my wife as above mentioned in said land)
Three Negroes, namely Sam, Tony and Bille my large ox cart
wheels with all its bodies my young yoke of Oxen and one
feather bed & furniture to his heirs and assigns forever —

Item. . . . I give and bequeath unto my son John Peter
Brack the land and plantation that I purchased of Lewis
Bryan dec'd and my three house Shays &c. the rest of
my property for him I have already delivered to him, namely
Negroes horses Cattle &c. together with the whole I give
to him his heirs and assigns forever —

Item. . . . Provided after the death of my wife Mary Brack
my son Martin Frank Brack will pay to my son Christo-
pher Brack and my daughter Penelope Jones one
hundred Dollars apiece. Thus my Will is that the
property lent my said wife Mary Brack and all
other property not mentioned in my Will belong to my
son Martin Frank Brack to him his heirs and assigns
forever —

Item. . . . I give and bequeath by equal divisions to my
two sons John Peter Brack and Martin Frank Brack all
my carpenter tools my crop cut & whip sawy one Dutch
Saw and one half of my plantation tools to them their
heirs and assigns forever —

..... I hereby consider that I have heretofore given
a full share of my whole to each of my six children
namely

32/ Namely Benjamin Brock, Christopher Brock, Elizabeth Rhen
Penelope Long, Mary B. Fenwick, and Sarah Himes, (that
is to say after my Son & Heir Frank Brock pay to Christopher
Brock and Penelope Jones, the before mentioned hundred doll
ars & pence)

I and Lastly... I nominate constitute and appoint my two
sons John & John Brock and a Martin Frank Brock & Co. to
to this my last Will and Testament. In Witness whereof
I the said Joseph Brock have to this my last Will
and testament set my hand and affixed my Seal the
20th day of September Anno Domini 1809.

In the name of God Amen. — I Daniel Noble being
weak of body, but of perfect sound mind & memory
(Ally h' God) do this day make and publish this my
last Will & Testament in manner & form following
that is to say principally and first of all I give
and recommend my soul into the hands of God who
gave that gave it, my body I recommend to the
Earth to be buried in a decent Christian like manner
— Touching worldly estate wherewith it has pleased God
to bless me with in this life I give devise & dispose
of them in form following. — Infirmities —
I give & bequeath unto my beloved wife Levecia
Noble, one bed and furniture one chest & one trunk and
one bag wheel and off my house hold and kitchen
furniture, also eleven dollars & two shillings due from
Benj. Harrison for labour done. Also one cow & calf
and two yearlings to her & her heirs & apogues for ever
Also I give & bequeath to my son Jeremiah Noble
the following notes (viz) Three notes on John C. Huxley
one for three hundred and fifty dollars, and one for
three hundred & forty Dollars the other for nine dollars
and on Isaac James for fifty two dollars & a half
one on The Ramsey for seven dollars and a half
and on Benj. Rachelle for Ten Dollars, and one note
on Em. Gannon Cont. for Twenty three pounds do. also
two notes on Caunters, two on Carter, one on James Jones
and one on Perry which said last mentioned notes
was left in the hands of Benj. Sutton to get judgments
on them, also one account against Isaac James
for five thousand Staves at twenty dollars for the same
and two thousand Staves at Nether Shutter Landing &
three sides of Leather at James James and one side
of leather at Sam. Harrison — also one Shot Gun — my
Will and desire is that my Exor. pay all my just
debts out of the part that I have left to my son
Jeremiah, and the remainder to my said Jeremiah
Noble his heirs and apogues for ever, and I do here
— by revoke & disannul and my other Testament Will
or Wills heretofore by me made, and do ratify and
confirm this and no other to be my last will and
Testament — Lastly I do nominate and appoint
my worthy friend Richard Noble & William Noble
my whole and sole Executors to this my last Will
and Testament —

as his last Will & Testament in
