This Twenty Third day of November 1797 Jones County  
being sick, but of perfect mind & memory, thanking be to God  
for the same, calling to mind the mortality of my Body, it  
being appointed to all Men once to die, do make & order this  
my last Will & Testament, I give & dispose of the same in the  
following Manner & form; That is to say —  
Item. My Will is that all just Debts be paid by my  
Executor out of my Estate in a convenient Time after my decease  
Item. I send to my beloved Wife Sada Wood one featherbed  
and Furniture One Iron Pot & Kettle, 2 Citter, 2 Spinning  
One Pewter Dish, & half a Dozen Pewter Plates, during her  
natural life, or Widewhood.  
Item. I give & bequeath unto my Son Peter Wood One Tract  
of Land lying in Duplin County containing One hundred  
and Sixty Acres to him & his Heirs for ever. to be sold  
as soon as can be conveniently after my decease, &  
over half of the Money arising from the Sale of said  
Land I give to my Son William Wood to him & his Heirs  
for ever. also I give to my Son Peter One Boar Mane  
that he has in his keeping now, also I give to my Son  
William One 2 Year Heifer & one Hand Saw  
Item. I give to my Daughter Mahaley Angel One  
Feather Bed, One Pewter Dish, & one Spinning Wheel,  
One Iron Citter  
Item. I give unto my Daughter Mary Wood One feather  
Bed & Furniture, & one Cow & Year old  
Item. I give to my Daughter Nancy Wood one Feather Bed  
& Furniture, & one four Year old Heifer  
Item. I leave to my beloved Wife Sada Wood & my Sons John  
Wood, & Anthony Wood & Daniel Wood all the Remainder of my  
Estate that I have not given away during my Wife Widewhood,  
& at her Death I give unto my Sons all the Estate that I have  
left to my Wife to be equally divided between John, Anthony  
& Daniel Wood. It is to be understood that my Debts is to be  
paid out of this last part of my Estate, in & hereby appoint my  
beloved Wife Sada Wood my Executor, with my Son Peter  
Wood my Executor of this my last Will & Testament as my sole  
Heir & Seal in presence of us — Jonathan Wood, John  
George Hagan, John Farley, Amos Angel

of Gray of Jones County & State of North Carolina being very  
weak of Body, but of sound & perfect Mind & Memory, & calling  
unto Mind the mortality of my Body, & knowing that it is ap-  
pointed for all Men once to die, do constitute & ordain  
this my last Will & Testament in Manner & form following,  
that is to say, principally I first of all I recommend my Soul  
into the Hands of Almighty God who gave it, my Body to the  
Earth to be buried in decent Christian Burial at the discre-  
tion of my Executors after named — First — my Will and  
testament that my just Debts & General Charges be paid by my  
Executors —  
Item. I give to my beloved Wife Elizabeth Gray, One Mane  
One Cow & Calf & Two Heifers, One Bird & Furniture together  
with One half of my Household Furniture to her, her Heirs &  
Assigns for ever —  
Item. Give to my Daughter Elizabeth Gray One Bed &  
Furniture together with One Cow & Calf & One Heifer, & the remain-  
ing half of my House-hold Furniture —  
Item. Give to my Son Sarah Gray One Horse, Bridle & Saddle  
One Cow & Calf & one Heifer, together with all my Plantation  
Tools & Farming Utensils —  
And I also give my Flock of Hogs & Pigs to my Wife & Two  
Children to be equally divided between them —  
I also nominate & appoint my Wife & my Son Sarah Gray, Ex-  
ecutors, to this my last Will & Testament, & do hereby utterly dis-  
allow, I revoke & disannul all & every other former Testaments, Wills,  
Legacies, Bequests & Executors by me given and wised before naming  
this Will & bequeath'd — Ratifying & confirming this & no other to  
be my last Will & Testament — In witness whereof I have  
hereunto set my Hand & Seal the 11th Day of February 1798 —  
Signed, sealed, published & promulgated by the hand of Joseph Gray  
the 11th day of February 1798 — W. W. T. stamp affixed

Also I give to my Sister Barbara Meade one Heifer  
Beef & one small brindle Steer Yearling,  
Also I give to my Sister Hannah Collins Two Cows, Five  
& Gentle, & their Calves to my Nephew Ben. Collins —  
Also I give to my Nephew Stephen Rachel West one Cow called  
Whitebacked & give to my Nephew Charity Meade one cow called  
Snow — I give to my Nephew Israel Collins one Three year old Heifer  
Also I give to my Sister Sophia West three Gowns, one  
Striped Bonnet, one yellow flower'd Bonnet, one striped Home  
spun one Coat pattern — Also I give to my Nephew  
Nancy Meade one Gown red flower'd Bonnet  
Also I give to my Nephew Polly Collins one White Muslin  
Gown, and my Nephew Barbara Collins one Red Cloak  
and all the remainder part of my Estate that is not mentioned  
is made to be equally divided between my Two Sisters Barbara  
Meade & Hannah Collins — Also I constituted  
myself John Collins & my Nephew Ben. Collins & Barbara  
Collins my whole body Executors of this my last Will &  
Testament — After my death shall show twenty first of

my Land, to her & her Heirs & Assigns for ever — I also send  
her the other half during her natural Life or Widowhood —  
Item, I give unto my Daughter Susanna Chancie Twenty  
Shilling —

Item, I give unto my Daughter Sarah Williams One hundred  
& Forty four Acres of Land at my Death, also that other hundred  
& Forty four Acres at my Wife's Death or Marriage, to her & her  
Heirs & Assigns for ever — Item, I give unto my Wife's Daughter Ann Murphy One  
Tea Caddy Bed & Furniture & One Heifer Earling, & One Sow & Pig  
to her Heirs or Assigns for ever — Item, the half of my Estates sent to my Wife, I leave to be sold  
at my Wife's Death or Marriage & the Money to be equally di-  
vided the Children of Sarah Williams, & William Herbert likewise  
first paying all my just Debts — Item, I hereby nominate & appoint my beloved  
Wife Priscilla Herbert, & Benjamin Williams Executors of this my last  
Will & Testament whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this  
Year first above written & published by the William Herbert
