I Joseph Whitty of the County of Jones and State of North Carolina  
Seriously Considering the uncertainty of life And mindful of the obligation upon  
every man to leave his affairs in order to make and declare this my last Will  
And Testament in manner and form following  
Imprimis. It is My desire that my Executors herein After Mama Should legate  
estate and pay all my just debts and to facilitate which I wish all my Negroes  
and Stock as they now are to be kept on my Plantation till the Crop of the  
present year is made harvest and disposed of after which I wish all my  
property and Assets herein after devised sold at public Sale and all debts due and collectible  
as speedily as convenient.

Item I give to my Son Joseph C. Whitty all my lands whereon I live including  
the Watch and Seat and a portion of the Davis land to him his heirs and  
aspirations forever.

Item I end to my Daughter Mary C. Kinsey during her natural life under the  
control and subject to the management for the benefit of her my said daughter of  
My Fiance James W. Howard whom I hereby appoint Trustee to superintend said  
Blessings as he may deem most beneficial to her my said daughter the following  
Names Negroes Amy, Betty, Dick, Phiby, Jane, William, Phillie, David,  
Maria, and Ben, also all my right and interest in and to the following Names  
Negroes Stephen, Jack and Maria, and Shanda my said Daughter Mary C.  
Kinsey leaves Children of her own body living at her death then I give the above  
Names Negroes together with their increase to such Child or Children of her  
my said daughter to be equally and fairly divided Shanda then be more than one  
Child but if my said daughter Mary C. Kinsey leaves no Child at her death then  
I give the said Negroes and their increase to my Son Joseph C. Whitty to  
him his heirs and aspirants forever.

Item I give to my Son Joseph C. Whitty the following Named Negroes Oscar,  
Pat ante Childa Joanie, Mahala, Elvanny, Rambal, William, Cornelius,  
Dolly, John, Thomas, Hagar, Jeps, Sise, Sam, Sophia, Sarah, Sam, Massa,  
James and Childa Homes, William and Leth, and Luke also my mare green blue to  
him his heirs and aspirants forever.

Item I give to Edward Whitty the following Name Negro Davy (Harvey)  
and Antaca to him his heirs and aspirants forever, I would mention for the satisfaction  
of all concerned that the Negroes in my Possession pass by the  
Will of Silby Jones and not having Mama, I am advised will descend equally  
to all the Children of my late wife Nancy, to which Negroes I have no other claim  
than that of my two children Mary C. Kinsey and Joseph C. Whitty except that I  
choose the interest of the late Edward G. Ferrara, and George W. Ferrara in and to  
said negroes subject to my claims on them the said Edward G. Ferrara died  
and George W. Ferrara for money to answer them and pay out for them for a  
part only of which I have their obligations, having paid some considerably

Amount in Banks in Newbern and cannot ascertain the amount  
without referring to said Banks.

On collecting the proceeds of the sale of such property as I have left to be sold and money now due me there should be a surplus over debt owing by me, then I give the said surplus to Edward Whitley to him his heirs and assigns forever but should there be a deficiency for the payment of all my just debts I wish said deficiency raised from the rest of the lands and heir of the Negroes passed by me in this my will & everowing therewith annually a sufficient sum for the support of my daughter Mary C. and Joseph C. out of such portion of said property as are willed to them respectively provided it can be raised in due time in this way, and if it cannot I wish said deficiency to be raised by the sale of Negroes having regard to be so made as equally to effect the intent of my two children Mary C. Kinsey and Joseph C. Whitley.

And lastly I nominate and appoint my worthy friend James W. Howard Executor to this my last Will and Testament whom I also nominate and appoint Guardian to my son Joseph C. Whitley by Testimony of all of which I do hereunto set my hand and affix my seal to this my last will and testament the 1<sup>st</sup> day of February A.D. 1813
