First I recommend my Soul to the keeping of the  
mighty God that gives it me and my Body to be interred  
in a decent Christian manner at the discretion of my  
Executor herein after named nothing doubting but I  
shall leave the same again through the mighty power  
of God & as touching such worldly Estate of both  
Please God to keep me with I give & Bequeath  
the same in manner following (to wit) —

Item. I will that the part of my personal Estate  
not herein after particularly devised be sold & my  
just debts paid & from the rest so much thereof as  
from the burden I will that my Son James &  
my nephew Ben Henderon Dallaz to him his wife &  
offspring forever —

Item, I send unto my beloved wife Sarah during  
her natural life the plantation & improvements where  
or I now live also, the plantation being one man by  
the name of Lark, three Cows & Calves one Yoke of  
Steers twenty head of Hogs my Breakfast & Bedchamber  
the Spinning & weaving making my Kitchen furniture  
two feather Beds bedsteads & furniture my Negro  
boy Bob. the foregoing I send my wife during her  
natural life —

Item. My Will is that my Es<sup>r</sup> lay off & allot to  
my wife & daughter Bathsheba for their Yearly exp-  
-pense thirty bushels Corn out of the Barn made this  
Side of the River the Whole of my Peas and a  
Sufficient quantity of Pease also one thousand Pounds  
Butter.
