I Rame Lyssey of the State & County of said being sick of body but of sound mind & memory thank God for the same do this 13th day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & seven make and declare this my last will & testament in manner following

First I recommend my soul to the blessing of the mighty God that gave it me and my body to be buried in a decent Christian manner at the discretion of my Executors herein after named nothing doubting but I shall receive the same again through the mighty power of God & as touching such worldly Estate as hath pleased God to bless me with I give & bequeath the same in manner following (to wit)

Item. I will that the part of my personal Estate not herein after particularly devised be sold & my just debts paid from the m^o proceeds thereof & from the residue I will that my son Samy Lyssey receive one hundred Dollars to him by him & apportion for use

Item. I send unto my beloved wife Sarah during her natural life the plantation & improvements thereon I now live also the plantation tools one mare by the name of Lark, three cows & calves one young strong twenty head of hogs my sheep & Cuckery the spinning & weaving machine my kitchen furniture two feather beds beds & furniture my Negro boy Bob. the foregoing I send my wife during her natural life

Item. My will is that my E^x lay off & allot to my wife & daughter Bathstaba for their year support thirty barrels Corn out of the Corn made this side of the river the whole of my Pig and a sufficient quantity of Potatoes also one thousand pounds
