In the Name of God Amen I Alexander Taylor of the County of Jesse formerly being sick and weak In body but in perfect mind and memory thanks be to God for the same Calling to mind the Mercy & truth of my Duty and knowing that it is appointed for all men and women once to Die do make and ordain this my last will and Testament that is to say for everlastingly and first of all I give and recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty God that gave it and my body I recommend my to the earth to be buried in Decent Christian burial at the Discretion of my Executors nothing Doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God and a Touching such worldly estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me in this Life I give and devise of the same in the following manner and form first I give and bequeath Alexander Taylor my beloved son one Cow and a half also my beloved Daughter Rebekah Thutson one Cow and half three pewter plates and one five point barn also to my Daughter Mary Stotts one Cow and half Also to Sarah Thutson one Cow and half three pewter plates and a half gallon Pason = Also to my son Isaac Thutson one hundred acres of Land on the West side of Truss Swamp also one Bed and furniture one Horse also I give to my Daughter Sarah one Bed and furniture one Cow and Carting three pewter plates one Gallon Pason = Also I give to my three sons John Thutson Jesse Thutson and Elijah Thutson twenty Shillings apiece to be raised out of my Estate Also I give to my Daughter Elizabeth Thutson one Bed and furniture three pewter
