

In the Name of God Amen

I Lavinia Con of the County of Jones & State of North Carolina being in perfect health, but knowing that I am appointed for all men once to die, do make and ordain this my last Will & Testament in manner and form as follows (Beg) -

1st - I recommend my soul to almighty God who gave it me and my body to be buried in a Christian like manner at the discretion of my Executors.

2^d - I give and bequeath unto my daughter Lavinia Con one feather bed and a furnished room chest to her, her heirs and assigns forever -

3^d - I give and bequeath unto my son John H. Con, one feather bed & furniture and one chest to him his heirs and assigns forever -

4th - My will and desire is, that the residue of my property be sold and the profits arising therefrom, after paying my just debts, be equally divided between my daughter Lavinia & my son John H. Con, to them their heirs and assigns forever, My will further is that should either of my above mentioned children die without lawful issue, that their part of my property shall go to the surviving one, and should both of them arrive to mature age and without lawful issue, that my property be equally divided among my other children -

5th - I nominate and appoint and do by these presents nominate and appoint my friend James Jones Esq. as Executor to this my last Will and Testament - Rescinding all former wills. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the 13th of May 1831 -
