4th My will and desire is, that the residue of my property be sold
and the profits arising therefrom, after paying my just debts, be
equally divided between my daughter Lavinia & my son John H. Cox, to
them their heirs and assigns forever, my will further is that should
either of my above named children die without lawful issue, that
their part of my property shall go to the surviving one, and should both
of them die to Matern's eye and without lawful issue, that my
property be equally divided among my other children —

5th I nominate and appoint and do by these presents nominate and
appoint my friend James Jones Esq^r as Executor to this my last Will
and Testament — retaining all former testator. In witness whereof I have
