



I also give to my son Harde paper a young Black Horse Lane  
 to my son John Nely a bay mare Child and to my son  
 Leubi a young sorrel Mare & to my son Nathan a pair  
 Sweeper hold to Harry my Riding Saddle and Bridle  
 I give to each of my four sons a feather Bed and  
 furniture to be reserved, or procured for them - all  
 remainder of my Estate I leave to be sold and the money  
 to be applied as is directed for the application of my land and  
 if any of my land shall remain unsold at the arrival of  
 Lady's day of my son Harry's death that it be then sold  
 if any of my Executors or the Land shall be living and if none  
 be living that the Land shall then remain unsold be not  
 sold till my son John shall arrive at Lawfull age to be  
 then sold in order for a Division or either of these cases the  
 Land to be sold at public Sale and on a suitable Credit  
 in case of the Death of my Executor a Deed by my two  
 sons being of full age to be taken My will is that my four  
 be kept at school until they be old enough to be bound out  
 that then my Executor lead them to such trade as they shall  
 choose and Circumstances shall best point out and lastly I  
 nominate and Appoint my two Brothers Nathar & John  
 Bryan my son in Law Leubek Vestry My Trusty friend Dwan-  
 Motes and my son Hardy paper my Executor of this  
 my last Will and Testament requesting that they will  
 see the same Decreed whom I also appoint Guardians  
 to my Children and for their Trouble I will that they  
 make and be allowed such a charge as they may think  
 equitable In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my  
 hand and Affixed my seal this 29th day of October  
 in the year of our Lord 1793

 I also give my wife Mary a pair of enellahyany Downy Table  
 & one feather Bed & saddle to the furniture before given her  
 I order my Executor to purchase for her one Complot set of  
 Chair Harnup  
 I give & Bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Vestry one  
 Negro boy called Jimmy in lieu of one Colled to the Colled  
 Deed which I have sold I also lend unto my Daughter  
 Elizabeth a pair of the Sixty acre of Land with all the  
 Improvement thereon also the Land & Improvement thereon  
 which I purchased at a Sheriff Sale the Estate of Richard  
 Williamson dec. During the term of Ten years after my  
 Decease  
 And whereas in my Will I have given my Executor Deed to  
 sell all my Land I now request them to sell no more over the  
 than that is absolutely necessary to go with the mill for the  
 Convienency thereof unless three of my heirs come of age & then  
 I order that it shall be sold at public Vendue to the  
 Highest bidder The Land & Improvement lent unto my  
 Daughter Elizabeth are not to be sold until the Loan is out  
 & then to be sold at public Vendue in all other Land sold  
 under the Will In Witness whereof I have hereunto  
 set my hand & seal this Day & year first herein written  
 I do hereby acknowledge this to be a part of my last Will  
 & Testament

 Intervent of Lord and Redeemer Lewis Clark and my two  
 I bequeath to the earth, Thus I disal that my Livestock  
 Cattle Sheep & farming utensils be sold at public auction  
 by my Executors at a Credit of Nine months and that the  
 Money arising therefrom together with all the monies that  
 are or may be due to me be bonds bills notes or  
 other Contract be disposed of in the first place to pay  
 all my just debts then that the residue arising there  
 from be divided share and share alike between the  
 Children of my late Sister Sarah Anne Hem. Give and  
 bequeath to John Devereux Junr my negro boy Slave named  
 Moses son to Bristol to him his heirs Executors and  
 assigns forever Hem. Give and bequeath to Thomas  
 Devereux my negro boy Slave named Bristol son  
 to Bristol aforesaid to him his heirs Executors and  
 administrators and assigns forever Hem. Give and  
 bequeath to Elizabeth C. Devereux my Negro girl  
 named Kate's Daughter to old yellow Glop to her  
 her Executors administrators and assigns forever  
 Hem. To such Child as Francis Devereux my next  
 have and bequeath my Negro girl named  
 Sally Hem as to all the rest of my Estate both  
 real & personal of every kind with whatsoever I hereby  
 give Devore and bequeath the same to my good  
 and affectionate wife Elizabeth to her her  
 Executors administrators and assigns forever  
 Lastly I hereby appoint my said wife Elizabeth my  
 sole Executrix of the my Last will and Testament  
 signed sealed and acknowledged in the presence  
 of Edward Graham Thomas Williams
