Item I give and bequeath unto my son John Quillen
one shilling Sterling and also all my estate of what
ever kind shall remain after the death of my wife

Eleanor to him and his heirs forever.
Lately I appointed and appointed my trusty friend Matthew
Romance and my loving son John Quillen Executors of this
my last will and Testament to perform the same according
to the true intent and meaning of the same and I do here
by revoke and disannul all other former wills or writings hereof

ny Tea Chest one pair of silver Tea Trays one pair
Gold Silver buttons and one plain gold ring It is also my
will and desire that negro Peter shall be divided out year-
ly by my Executors named and the money arising from
the said Peter when amounting to a sufficient sum to -
purchase a negro Girl therewith for my said Daughter
Sarah to her, her heirs and assigns forever.

Item I give bequeath and devise unto my Cousin William
Clyde two Cows and Cows or yearlings of his choice.

Item I give bequeath and devise unto my Niece Margra-
et Smith one Colt about a year old and one Gold-
-stone ring to her her heirs and assigns forever.

It is also my will and desire that the negro wench ca-
-med Betty shall be & remain with my two Children in
the possession of my Brother in Law David Smythe
or one of their heirs & that my Sister Jane Smythe
shall have as my Clothes. It is my will & desire that the
rest of all my Estate not herein particular devised shall
be sold at public sale at the direction of my Executors
after named and the monies arising therefrom shall
be equally divided between my Son Robert and my
Daughter Sarah Hargrave.

It is also my will & desire and I do hereby appoint my
Brother in Law David Smythe and my friend John Hargrave
to be my true & lawful Executors of this my last will
and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand and seal this 1st day of January 1786
