ling Sterling money.

Imprimis I give unto my Daughter Mary Littleton one shilling
Sterling money.

Imprimis I give unto my son James Huggins one shilling
and heirs forever.

Imprimis I give unto my son Luke Huggins one shilling
Sterling to him and heirs.

Imprimis I give unto my son Isaac Huggins one shilling
Sterling to him and his heirs.

Imprimis I give unto my son Jacob Huggins the plantation
I now live on with all the rest of my Lands to him and his
heirs and assigns forever.

Imprimis I give all the rest of my estate of all kind whatsoever
to my five youngest Children Esther Huggins Panna Huggins
Thomas Huggins Charles Huggins and Temperance Huggins to be
equally divided among them at my wife's Death or marriage
I shewen I constitute and name Simon Knight and John
Perry Executors of this my last will and Testament I do hereby
utterly revoke and annul all other Wills or Testaments ratify-
ing and confirming this and no other as my last Will and
Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my

last will and Testament in manner and following—
Imprimis I bequeath to my beloved wife Hester Giles the use of
my plantation whereon I now live with all the stock with what
nature soever and every plantation tool during her
widowhood and no longer and whenever she marries I
give and bequeath to my said wife and my Children—
which may then be unmarried all my aforesaid stock and
plantation tools to be equally between them share and share
alike. Item I bequeath to my beloved wife the four following
negroes for and during her natural life namely Venture,

Luke Huggins

Pat. Cloe, Scada and young Pott the Daughter of Cloe and
after her death I intend that four of the said negroes namely
Venture Pott Cloe and Scada, be sold at Public Vendue by my
Executors hereafter named and the money arising from the sale
thereof to be equally divided among all my Children and I do
give and bequeath the aforesaid young Pott and her increase to
my son William Giles after the death of his mother as aforesaid
Item I give to my beloved wife all my household furniture of
what kind or nature soever the furnishing cash of my Children
own which at my death may be unmarried one good feather
bed and bedding whenever they or either of them shall come
of age or be married.—

Item I give and bequeath to my beloved Daughter Ann Man-
get two negroes named Lucy and Simon and the increase
of the said Lucy to her, her heirs and assigns forever.

Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Chris-
tian Lottan two negroes named Pottet and Dick and the incre-
ase of the said Pottet to her her heirs and assigns forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my beloved Daughter Susanna
Living two negroes named Moll & Lane and their increase to
her her heirs and assigns forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my beloved Daughter Eliza
both her two negroes named Venus and Phillis and their
increase to her her heirs and assigns forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter Fudge her two
negroes named Hannah and Sarah and their increase to my
said beloved Daughter Fudge her heirs and assigns forever.

Item I give and bequeath to my beloved Daughter Mary
both two negroes named Tomp and Rachel and their
