people to die I do make and ordain this my last will and Testament
in manner and form following that is to say First I give my soul to God

2nd I give and devise unto my beloved son Richard Noone one note James Reynolds
and two cows and calves one bold Pig and one dollar in Quarter or horse
money that I now have in hand to live his his forever

3rd I desire that all the residue of my property should be sold and the money
equally divided between my two sons Benjamin and Richard after all my
just debts are paid and funeral charges

4th I nominate and appoint to this my last Will and Testament my beloved
Mother in Law Benjamin Noone Executors in witness whereof I do hereunto
set my hand and seal this 3rd of April 1824 signed sealed and delivered
