James County Malissa T. Robertson of the State and County aforesaid
Do this the second day of November in the year of our Lord and Thousand
eight Hundred & thirty Seven make & publish this my last Will & Testaments
in manner & form as follows that is to say I give & bequeath to my grandson
NIGHT Robertson the fourth part of my Plantation between the main Road &
Blaven Creek beginning on the line on the South side running so as to make the four
lots of an equal breadth on the South line & near equal on the North line as it
can to make the four lots of Equal number of acres I Give & bequeath to my Daughter
Hester Robertson the first lot that is wherein I now live the second lot adjoining
on the west side to my Daughter Rebekah Cox I give & bequeath the third lot on the
west side of the same lot & adjoining to my Granddaughter Dorothy Robertson
I give & bequeath the fourth lot on the west side of the third lot & on the north side
of the main Road & adjoining the same containing the buildings wherein my son
Bliska Robertson now lives. I also give each of the lots before mentioned the
privilege of all my lands that is not heretofore mentioned

wherein I have hitherto set my hand & affixed my seal
