I James McDaniel of the County and State aforesaid being weak in
body but of perfect sound mind and memory doth by these my 35th
day of May in the year of our Lord Christ 1809 make & publish the my
last will & Testament in manner & form following —

First, I give unto my Son William McDaniel three Pines of Land namely
one acre from James Miller one from William Smith his and one
from Roderick McDaniel to him his heirs and assigns for ever —

Item, I leave unto my dearly beloved wife Rachel all the lands that was
left to me by my father till during her natural life —

Item, I give unto my grand Son Robert McDaniel all the land that was
left to me by my father after the death of my wife and shall be de-
dicted to her I give the land left to me by my Father to Margaret
Elizabeth Giltner to be equally divided among them —

Item, I give unto my Son James McDaniel the Brother, place an all the
Land on the South side of the road and on the North side of Creek
run to quicksilver to him his heirs and assigns for ever —

Item, I leave all the land on the South side of Creek run to be sold by my
Executor Item, I give unto my Son Roderick McDaniel all the land on
the North side of the said road gaining his own land to him his heirs
and assigns joined — Item, I leave all my lands in Anson
County to be sold by my Executor, Also two other pieces of Land
one a being by John Gilbert and the other a being by Joseph Gilbert
and all my land that is not wished to be sold by my Executor —

Item, I give unto my dearly beloved wife one bay mare by the name
of Wallie and one feather bed & furniture & one Cow & Calf and
one sow & pigs two peacock dukes six plates two chairs one chest
and one Table & two pots — Item, And all the residue of
my Estate to be sold by my Executor and after paying my just
debts, I give unto my Son Roderick McDaniel One Hundred Dollars
Cash and the remainder to be ~~equally~~ divided among my five daugh-
ters and three grand children in manner and form following namely —

I give to Agg McDaniel two Shillings and unto Mary McDaniel one Shill-
ing and Nancy Murphy one Shillings and unto Mary Brown one Shillings and
to Susannah Gilbert one Shillings, James Andrews, Susanna Andrews and
Mary Andrew one Shillings if they arrive to the age of Twenty One —

I hereby nominate constable & appoint my Son Roderick McDaniel and
William McDaniel my two sons Bequests to this my last will & Testament
hersby revoking & disannulling all other wills by me hitherto made in
Testamentary witness I have caused to set my hand and seal the day
and year first written written —

I Mary Frazer of Jony County and State of North Carolina being

perfect understanding do make & ordain this to be my last will and

that all my just debts and other expenses inferring to satisfy & pay
I also will & bequeath unto my grandson Michael Matticks one
hundred & fifty Dollars to be paid out of the money or notes
which I have sold my negro Sutton for, at said Michael Matticks
ariving at the age of Twenty one years, I also will & bequeath
unto my grandson Frazer Burnet one hundred and fifty dollars
to be paid out of the money or notes for said Sutton, This
is my will also that my negro woman Doll & doll & doll and the
money he put at Interest and reserved for my grand Daughters
Nancy Burnet and be paid to her when she arrives to Twenty
one years of age on marriage, It is also my will that there
should be a sum of money equal to what said Doll shall
sell for living & rained out of my property not of & wills
and paid to my Grand Daughters Nancy Matticks when she
shall arrive at Twenty one years of age on marriage, I also
will & bequeath unto my grandson Bishop Dreddy one
hundred Dollars to be living & rained out of my Stark &
household furniture, I also will unto my grandson Osborne
Baldwin my negro boy Jack to him & his heirs forever —

I also will unto my grandson Michael Frazer Fifty Dollars
to be rained & paid out of my Stark & household furniture
It is also my will that the residue & remaining part of my
property not yet given & bequeathed be equally divided among
my three children hereafter mentioned (viz) Sally Burnet
Abbie Matticks and James Frazer for them and their
heirs forever, and I do hereby nominate and appoint

My trusty friend Stephen Williams Sase executor to this my last Will and Testament and revoking all other my former Wills & will Legatus Legatee & Executor by me before made or given do ratify and Confirm this to be my last will and testament this 14th day of June 1809.

I Thomas Barret of Jones County and State of North Carolina being weak in body but of perfect Saines mind and memory do make constitute and Ordain this my last will & Testament in manner & formes as follows that is principally and first of all I recommend my soul to God that gave it and my body to the Earth from whence it was taken to be buried in a decent forme — Imprimis, I give & bequeath to my daughter Polly Lee one hundred pounds to her & her heirs forever — Item, I give & bequeath to my beloved wife Nancy eight Cows & Calves during her weddhood and if she do remain during her natural life for the use of Raising & maintaining of my two youngest children also I bind unto my beloved wife Nine head of young cattle for the use of Clathing & Schooling my two children also Thirty head of hoggs during her weddhood also one mare and all my household furniture and plantation tools during her weddhood my will and desire is that as much of the before mentioned property shall be sold at six monthly credit as will satisfy all my debts

Just Debts and necessary expences with what is now due me Item, I give & bequeath to my two children Tanner and Asaph after my wife death or widow all the before mentioned property and its income to them & their heirs & assigns forever if in case either of my children should die before they die of lawfull age or having lawfull heir of their body my desire is that the surviving one shall have it & her heirs forever Lastly I nominate and appoint my wife Elizabeth wife and my friend Jacob Fox my sole acting Executor to this my last will & Testament and hereby revoking all other wills and testaments made this to be my last Will & Testament signed & published at, the 28th day of May 1809 I further desire that if either of my Execs should die or become incapable to act I nominate and appoint my friend William Gates as one of my Execs to this my last will & Testament
