Jones County Court May Term 1815.

There was the above Will of Thomas McQuilling produced in open Court and duly
proved by the oaths of Dadock Ashen & Stancy Ashen the two subscribing Witnesses
as thereto. and at the same time Benjamin Harrison the executor therein named
Qualified as such agreeable to Law - orancea that Letters Testamentary issue accord-
ingly:

State of North Carolina Jones County June 10th 1813
In the name of God Amen I Mary Hay, being sick and in
body but of a perfect sound mind and memory do make this my last
Will & Testament revoking all others Wills and knowing that we must
all die and submit my soul to God that gave it and my body to the
Earth from whence it came to be buried decently at the discretion
of my Executors -

I do will and bequeath my little estate in manner & form followeth
I wit I give to my three Sons William Hay, Joseph Hay and
George Hay all my property that I am now posset of except
Two small Heifers to be equally divided amongst them to them
their Heirs and assigns forever after my just debts is paid I give
to Jacob Sanders one Leather Bed now in his possession if he will
take it in the lew of half a Bed Willed to my daughter at my death
by her father if not let the Bed be sold and he have half the money
I give to my two grand Daughters Polly & Elizabeth Sanders a hef-
fer yearling apiece to them their Heirs and assigns forever and
lastly I constitute and appoint my sons William Hay, Joseph Hay,
and George Hay my whole and sole Executors to this my last Will
and Testament this day and date above written in presence of

me.

There was the within Will duly proved in open Court by the oath of the
subscribing Witnesses and ordered to be recorded - at some time Will.
Hay qualified as Exec. thereto agreeable to Law - Ordered that Letters Testa-
mentary issue accordingly

In the name of God amen, I Edward Frank of the
County of Jones and State of North Carolina Planter being sick of body
but in perfect mind and diffisive memory calling to mind the mortality
of my body, and that it is appointed for all men once to die, do make and
declare this my last Will and Testament in manner and form as follows,
I wit First and principally I recommend and bequeath my soul to the
hand of almighty God who gave it, and my body to the dust from whence
it was taken to be buried in a decent and Christian like manner at the
bottom of a hill in the back of my house
