day of July in the year of ^{our} Lord 1782 make and Publish this
my last will ^{Testament} in manner and following. Vizt. -

First I Give and bequeath unto my Son in Law Hugh Bradshaw all my right and Title to a piece of Land containing
Two hundred Acons with all the appurtenances which I have
enjoyed whereon I now live to him his heirs and assigns forever
also one Dish and two good Plates and ^{one} old one (pewter) three
Spoons and one Pew and also one large jigg one frying pan
half dozen knives and forks to him his heirs and assigns forever
Item I give to my Son Robert King one large quilt one Ba-
son two good plates one old ~~one~~ plate (pewter) three spoons one
to one small Iron pot and large Cutlery two Bottles one
Jackhammer I also give to his Daughter Mary one pair of them
their heirs and assigns forever -

Item I give to my Daughter Sarah King father for one
Bed one Basin small Pinner one old Dish two good Plates
and four spoons (pewter) one box Iron and needles ~~and~~ Two
Junk bottles and I give unto his Daughter ^{Elizabeth} ~~one~~ one woollen
sheet to them their heirs and assigns forever

Item I give to my Grandson James Bradshaw my Bible - and
to his Brother Reuben Bradshaw one yearling heifer to them their
heirs and assigns forever.

Item I give to my Son in Law Hugh Bradshaw three cows and
one Basen and I give to his Daughter Emblen one Linen
sheet and to his son Richard one hatchet to them their heirs and
assigns forever.

I nominate constitute and appoint my son in law Hugh
Bradshaw Executor of this my last will and Testament in this
last whored. Have hereunto set my hand and Seal the day and
year first within written

To the said Mary Ring &c.

In the name of God Amen. I Nathl Richards of Jonesboro
and State of North Carolina planter being sick and weak in body
but of sound mind and memory and understanding do make
I publish this my last Will and Testament as Vint.

First of all I give & bequeath unto my well beloved Brother Bayard
Richards my negroe man Duke & my negroe boy Sam as also
my black Horse Rock and my flock of Cows unto the P. Bayard
Richards his heirs and assigns forever.

Then I give & bequeath unto my well beloved Brother Clement
Richards my black mare & bay Horse as also all my stock of
Cattle or Hogs of any other kind whatsoever as also one half.
