I Mary Murphy of the County of Jones & State of North Carolina being weak in body but of sound mind & memory do make & ordain this my last Will & Testament in manner & form following (viz), —

Item 1st. I recommend my soul to almighty God who gave it me, and my body to be buried in a christian like manner, at the discretion of my Executors —

Item 2^d. I give a bequest unto my grand son Frederick Donnell (son of Thomas J. Donnell) one Negro child named Anthony to him his heirs and assigns forever —

Item 3^d. My will & desire is that after my just debts is paid, that the residue of my property be equally divided between my three children William C. Murphy, Marinda Murphy, & Deborah Murphy, each one to receive their share, when arriving to matured age, to them their heirs and assigns forever —

Item 4th. I nominate and appoint my friend Emanuel Garmon Executor to this my last Will & Testament revoking all former Wills, In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 3^d of Jan^y. 1831. —
