(Note) The executor did not qualify and take the required oath

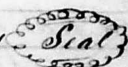

I Millington Meadows of the County of Jones and State of North Carolina being of sound mind and memory but considering the uncertainty of my earthly existence do make this and declare it to be my last will and testament and hereby revoke and making null and void all former Wills and Testaments First That my executor shall provide for my body a decent burial suitable to the wishes of my relations and friends and pay all funeral expenses together with my just debts here- before, and to whomsoever owing out of the moneys that I may first come into his hands as a part or parcel of my Estate Item I give and devise to the heirs of my son George H. Meadows a certain tract or parcel of Lands lying and being in Jones County adjoining the lands of George H. Meadows known as the land I purchased of Dr. Robert Egan containing two hundred acres more or less Item I give and devise to my son Christopher H. Meadows all my household and Kitchen furniture Stock of all kinds my Stock of Bees my farming implements of all kind together with this tract of Land containing three hundred acres more or less to hold with all appurtenances in fee simple also my free mark Lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my trusty friend Cyrus V. Foscoe my lawful executor to all intents and purposes to execute this my last will and testament according to the true intent and meaning of the same In witness whereof I the said Millington Meadows do hereby herewith set my hand and seal this the 11th day of September One thousand eight hundred and sixty five 1865
