 Kitchen furniture Stock of all kinds my Stock of Bees my farming implements of all
 kind together with this tract of Land containing Three hundred acres more or less
 to hold with all appurtenances in fee simple also my Negro mark

Lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my trusty friend Cyrus V. Foscar my lawful
 Executor to all intents and purposes to execute this my last Will and Testament
 according to the true intent and meaning of the same
