 the body and that it is appointed for all the human family once to die do
 recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty God that you at and my body
 to be decently buried in a Christian like manner at the direction of my Executors
 hereafter named — And as touching the little worldly goods which it
 has pleased God to bless me with I dispose of in manner & form following
 (viz) I bequeath my Will and desire is that my Executor shall pay the
 the Manner of my Estate I pay to White Busick, McDaniel and John
 the Daniel Sons of Miles McDaniel the sum of Fifty dollars each when
 they or either of them are in to the age of Twenty one years old &
 shall be to them their heirs and assigns forever — I give and bequeath unto
 the sum of Fifty one dollar to him & his heirs & assigns for ever
 I give and bequeath unto Susan Andrews daughter of Peter Andrews
 the sum of Fifty Dollars and one Cent to have in heirs and assigns
 for ever that Fifty dollars in Money to be paid by my Executor
 I give and bequeath unto White Andrews daughter of P. Andrews Fifty
 dollars to be paid as above when she arrives at Twelve years or more to her
 heirs & assigns for ever — I give and bequeath unto Peter Andrews
 four Children namely John, Peter, Mary Ann and Adam the sum of Forty
 dollars to be equally divided between them when they shall be to them
 their heirs and assigns for ever I give and bequeath unto Peter
 Andrews of the above four Children the sum of Twelve Dollars to him
 his heirs & assigns for ever — I give and bequeath unto Sally
 Busick daughter of Lemuel Busick one half & proportion to her & her heirs
 for ever — I give my Will is that all the Rest & Residue of my little estate
 be not heretofore divided I have to be Equally divided between Lemuel Busick
 and my Cousin Peter Andrews to them their heirs and assigns for ever
 Lastly I Nominate Constitute and Appoint Lemuel Busick and Peter
 Andrews Executors to this my last Will & Testament Reserving all other
 Wills heretofore by me made Acknowledging this to be my only & last
 Will. In witness whereof I hereunto set my hand & seal this 11th
 day of July 1825

In the name of God Amen, I Elizabeth Simmons of the
State of North Carolina & County of Jones Being of sound
and perfect Mind & Memory (Blessed be God) Do this the first
day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred & thirty six. Make and publish this my last Will
& testament in manner following that is to say —
First I give and bequeath unto Nathan Isaac a certain
Negro person named Maria Margaret and her two Children named
Marion and Charles I also give and bequeath unto the
Said Isaac all the rest of any of my property Excepting
such things as is here after mentioned (viz) I
do hereby give & bequeath unto my son and daughter Simmons
Sally Shepherd & Reuben Gunter Sixty five Dollars each —
that is to say in full — Thirdly I desire that my
Negro Man Willis should be sold & the ^{proceeds} should
be equally divided between the said Sally & Reuben Simmons
Sally Shepherd and Reuben Gunter —
Fourthly I give and bequeath unto Reuben Gunter one Bed on four
wheels and one White Cow for him — And I hereby make
Ordained Nathan Isaac Executor of my last Will & testament in
Witness whereof I the said Elizabeth Simmons have to this my last will
and testament what my hand and Seal the day and Year above
written — My name sealed published and Declared by the said
Elizabeth Simmons the testator as her last will and testament in the
presence of us who are present at the time Signing and sealing hereof —
