 they or either of them are in to the age of Twenty one years old &
 shall be to them their heirs and assigns for ever - I give and bequeath
 the sum of Fifty one dollar to Samuel Busick
 the sum of Fifty one dollar to him & his heirs & assigns for ever
 the sum of Fifty Dollars and one Cent to have in heirs and assigns
 for ever that Fifty dollars in Money to be paid by my Executor
 I give and bequeath unto Abigail Andrews daughter of P. Andrews Fifty
 dollars to be paid as above when she arrives at lawful age or marries to her
 heirs & assigns for ever - I give & bequeath unto Peter Andrews
 four Children namely John, Peter, Mary Ann and Adam the sum of Forty
 dollars to be equally divided between them when they shall be of age & to them
 their heirs and assigns for ever I give and bequeath unto Peter
 Andrews ~~the~~ the above four Children the sum of Twelve Dollars to him
 his heirs & assigns for ever - I give and bequeath unto Sally
 Busick daughter of Lemuel Busick one heire & jointure to her & her heirs
 for ever - I give my Will is that all the Rest & Residue of my little
 estate not heretofore divided I have to be Equally divided between Samuel Busick
 and my Cousin Peter Andrews to them their heirs and assigns for ever
 I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint Samuel Busick and Peter
 Andrews Executors to this my last Will & Testament Reserving all other
 Wills heretofore by me made Acknowledging this to be my only & last
 Will. In witness whereof I hereunto set my hand & seal this 11th
 day of July 1825

& Testament in Manner following that is to say —
First I give and bequeath unto Nathan James a certain
Negro person named Mimi Margaret and her two Children named
Marriet and Shanks I also give and bequeath unto the
Said James all the rest of any of my Property Excepting
Such things as is here after mentioned (Viz) I
charitably give & bequeath unto Polly and Beneter Simmons
Sons of Nathan & Rezen Gunter Sixty five Dollars each —
That is to say in Notes — Thirdly I desire that my
Negro Man Willis should be sold & the ^{proceeds} proceeds should
be equally divided between the Said Polly & Beneter Simmons
Sons of Nathan and Rezen Gunter —
Fourthly I give and bequeath unto Rezen Gunter one Bed one pair
sheets and one White Counter pin — And I hereby make
Nathan James Executor of my last Will & Testament in
Witness whereof I the said Elizabeth Simmons have to this my last will
and Testament set my hand and Seal the day and Year above
written — My name sealed published and Declared by the Said
Elizabeth Simmons the Testator as his last will and Testament in the
presence of us who are present, at the time Signing and sealing hereof —
