In the Name of God Amen the 6th Day of September 1778.—
I Peter Amiet of the County of Craven and State of North Carolina Clock Smith being very sick and weak of Body but of perfect mind and Memory thanks be given unto God for it therefore calling unto mind the Mortality of my Body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die Do make and Ordain this my last will and Testament that is to say principally and first of all give and recommend my Soul into the hands of God that gave it and my Body I recommend to the Earth to be Buried in decent Christian burial at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the General Resurrection of shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God and touching such worldly Estate as it hath pleased God to bestow me in this Life I give and demise and Dispose of the same in the following manner and form. I give and bequeath to my well beloved wife Mary Amiet all my houses and Household Furniture Except one Bed and one Little Chair and likewise all my stock of Tobacco and Toys and all my plantation Tools during her life or widowhood and to my beloved son William Fifty Acres of Land lying in the fork of the Branch where he now dwells and to my well beloved daughter Elizabeth I give one Bed and Furniture one little Chair and one gallon Basin and to my well beloved son John Fifty Acres lying on the North side of the Branch his brother Vincent Land Seven hundred by the patient Lane divided

By the Branch from his Brother Vincent Land and likewise a Mare called Phenix and to my well beloved son Creek I give Fifty Acres of Land be it more or less being the Remainder of the Land above I have Land well and to my Son Shadrack give my gun and my Tobacco Box I give to my Wife during her life and then to my son Peter and likewise Constituted make and Ordain my Well beloved wife Mary Amiet my Soul Executrix of this my last Will and Testament all and Singular my Lands and Tenements by her freely to be possessed and enjoyed and I do hereby at any Disposer and Reward and Reward all and every other former Testaments and Wills Legacies and Executors by me in any way before named Willed and bequeathed Ratifying this and Confirming this and no other to be my Last Will and Testament in Writing Whereof I have hereunto set the Day and Year above written

In the Name of God Amen I William Lavender of Jones County and State of North Carolina Being In good Health and perfect memory (Blessed be God therefore) do this Twenty Fourth day of May in the year of our Lord One Thousand and Seven hundred and Eighty nine and publish this my Last Will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say I Impose it I commend my Soul into the Hands of Almighty God who gave it me and my Body to the Earth from whence it came in hopes of a Joyful Resurrection through the Merits of my Saviour Jesus Christ And as for that worldly Estate which it hath pleased God to Bless me with I dispose thereof as follows First I give to my Son William Lane Lavender the plantation wherein I late lived Lying and being in the County of Craven with all the Lands now Acre and half being by Estimation Two hundred and Thirty Acres in three separate surveys joining each other Lying and being on Both sides Front Road near Beaver Creek to him his Heirs and Assigns for ever I also give to my d^r Son William W^m Lane Lavender Four Cows and Calves to be placed on his plantation as a Separate Stock for the use and benefit of my d^r Son when He shall arrive to age to him and his Heirs forever
