 Also I give to my Sister Barbara Meade one Feather
 Bed & Furniture & one small bairn steer Yearling —
 Also I give to my Sister Hannah Collins ^{one} cow, Sirey
 & Gentle & their Calves to my Nephew Ben Collins —
 Also I give to my Nephew Rachel West one cow call'd
 Whipback —
 Also I give to my Nephew Charity Meade one cow call'd
 Slow —
 Also I give to Nephew Isaac Collins one three year old Heifer
 Also I give to my Sister Sophena West, three Gowns, one
 striped Necktie, one yellow flower'd Calico, one striped Home-
 spun one Coat & pattern — Also I give to my Nephew
 Nancy Meade one Gown red flower'd Calico
 Also I give to my Nephew Polly Collins one white Muslin
 Gown, & and my Nephew Barbara Collins one Red Necktie,
 and all the remain'ing part of my Estate that is not mention'd
 to be equally divided between my two Sisters Barba-
 ra Meade & Hannah Collins — Also I constitute
 appoint John Collins & my Nephew Ben Collins & Barbara
 Meade my whole & sole Executors of this my last Will &

 last Will & Testament in Maner & form as follows, viz.
 I give, first I leave or lend unto my beloved Wife Priscilla
 Herbert One hundred & forty four Acres of Land being one half
 of the Land & Plantations whereon I now live during her natural
 Life, or Widowhood — I also give unto my Wife
 Priscilla the best One half of my Estate of all kind except
 my Lands, to her & her Heirs & Assigns for ever — I also lend
 her the other half during her natural Life or Widowhood —
 I give unto my Daughter Susanna Chance Twenty
 Shilling —
 I give unto my Daughter Sarah Williams One hundred
 & forty four Acres of Land at my Death, also the other hundred
 & forty four Acres at my Wife's Death or Marriage, to her & her
 Heirs & Assigns for ever —
 I give unto my Wife's Daughter Ann Murfey One
 Feather Bed & Furniture & One Heifer Carlings, & One Sow Pig
 to her Heirs or Assigns for ever —
 The half of my Estate lent to my Wife, I leave to be sold
 at my Wife's Death or Marriage & the Money to be equally di-
 vided betwixt the Children of Sarah Williams, & William Herbert I have
 first paying all my just Debts —
 I hereby nominate constitute & appoint my beloved
 Wife Priscilla Herbert, & Benjamin Williams Executors of this my last
 Will & Testament whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this
 sixth day of March 1790
